



After examining your Ground Water Registration Modification (GR Mod) Applications, there are some problems that need to be resolved before we can continue processing. Please provide the following information and/or materials:

- Need a notarized consent statement from Oregon State Hospital with regards to the four GR Mod Applications. The other alternative is to file a change in Certificate of Registration Assignment. The application form is available on our Department webpage.
- 2. If the lands the GR Mod Applications are proposing to transfer from have been sold and are currently under ownership other then the GR Mod applicants, the Department needs a notarized consent form from each landowner affected by the transfer.
- 3. The majority of the proposed lands affected by the GR Mod transfers are currently authorized by Certificate 68665. Parts of the Certificate 68665 associated with the from lands will need to be cancelled and the portions associated with the to lands will need to be either determined as supplemental, primary, or cancelled. This will require the notarized consent of the Certificate 68665 holder, Santiam Water Control District.
- 4. As the GR Mod Applications currently propose, the transfer of the Certificates of Registration creates an enlargement issue due to the authorized rate/duty and the number of proposed acres to be irrigated. There is also a 'layering' issue as the Applications propose to place two Certificates of Registration onto the same lands in conjunction with Certificate 68665. We will need to resolve these issues by either reducing acre size and/or creating supplemental rights.


