- \*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Permit S-12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Permit S-87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:
- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each permit involved as follows:
  - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the permit (for S-12345, 1.25 cfs  $\div$ 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be changed to get the application cfs (x 45 ac = 0.56 cfs).
  - b. If the water right permit does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For S-87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Add cfs for the portions of permits on all the land included in the application; however **do not count** cfs for supplemental permits on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary permit on the same land. The well installed near Authorized Well 1 was originally intended to be a test well to determine
the availability of water in the area. After installing the test well (now named Proposed Well 1)
we decided to use it for irrigation, recognizing it is not in an authorized location. We also
realized the cost to run electricity to this well and the other proposed wells was cost prohibitive
and left us with the option of supplying power to the well(s) using a portable generator. This
application proposes to add the "test well" and also to add other well locations closer to power
sources.
