SUBJECT: Water Right Transfer Application T-13031

Please find enclosed the Preliminary Determination indicating that, based on the information available, the Department intends to approve application T-13031. This document is an intermediate step in the approval process; water may not be used legally as proposed in the transfer application until a Final Order has been issued by the Department. Please read this entire letter carefully to determine your responsibility for additional action.

A public notice is being published in the Department's weekly publication and in the Woodburn Independent newspaper, simultaneously with issuance of the Preliminary Determination. The notice initiates a period in which any person may file either a protest opposing the decision proposed by the Department in the Preliminary Determination or a standing statement supporting the Department's decision. The protest period will end 30 days after the last date of newspaper publication.

If no protest is filed, the Department will issue a Final Order consistent with the Preliminary Determination. You should receive a copy of the Final Order about 30 days after the close of the protest period.

If a protest is filed, the application may be referred to a contested case proceeding. A contested case provides an opportunity for the proponents and opponents of the decision proposed in the Preliminary Determination to present information and arguments supporting their position in a quasi-judicial proceeding.

Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Applicant

THE BUCK FAMILY TRUST 17728 BUTTEVILLE RD NE WOODBURN, OR 97071

Findings of Fact

- 1. On September 20, 2018, The Buck Family Trust filed an application for additional points of appropriation under Certificate 35498. The Department assigned the application number T-13031.
- 2. On June 3, 2019, The Buck Family Trust amended the original application to request additional points of appropriation.
- 3. Notice of the application for transfer was published on September 25, 2018, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 4. Notice of the amended application for transfer was published on July 2, 2019, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 5. On August 5, 2019, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13031 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of September 5, 2019, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
- 6. On August 16, 2019, the Department requested the agent to send the original notarized Consent by Deeded Landowner, to be added to the application file. It was received on August 27, 2019.

7. The right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 35498 in the name of DON'S INC. (perfected under Permit G-3195)

Use: IRRIGATION of 290.8 ACRES

Priority Date: MARCH 3, 1966

Rate: 1.16 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

Limit/Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured

under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation

season of each year.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

- 9. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 10. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-13031.
- 11. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 12. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 13. All other application requirements are met.

Determination and Proposed Action

The additional points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-13031 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the application will be approved.

If Transfer Application T-13031 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- 1. The additional points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-13031 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 35498 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right Certificate 35498 is cancelled.
- 4. Water diverted at the new additional points of appropriation (Well 2 and Well 3), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (Well 1), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (Well 1).

- 5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
- 6. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2020**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 7. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.
