TERMS OF PAYMENT AND FREIGHT:

The scion, rootstock, vines, benchgrafts, and/or other material that are the subject of this contract (collectively referred to as "goods") are "goods" as that term is defined under Section 2107 of California's Uniform Commercial Code (UCC). The "Buyer" must satisfy the payments according to the "Payment Schedule" in order to secure the order of goods. If payments are not made according to the "Payment Schedule" Seller reserves the right to cancel the order, and Buyer agrees to forfeit all payments made. The balance is due in full at time of shipping of the goods (unless otherwise indicated in the contract). Unless otherwise stated in this contract, Buyer shall be responsible for the designation of the freight carrier who will deliver the vines. The sale price of the vines is FOB Seller's place of business (shipping point). In the event Buyer cancels the contract, all payments paid by Buyer to Seller shall be forfeited, and shall remain the property of the Seller, with no further obligation on the part of Seller.

CERTIFICATION OF PLANT MATERIAL:

All goods sold under this contract have been grown in accordance with the California Grape Vine Certification Program. Some of the certified grapevine material from California has been purchased from third parties, and certification tags have been issued to Seller.

SELLER MAKES NO WARRANTIES, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, AS TO THE DESCRIPTION, QUALITY, PURITY, RESISTANCE TO DISEASE, TRUENESS TO VARIETY OR PRODUCTIVENESS, OR AS TO ANY MATTER OR MERCHANTABILITY, IMPLIED MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE REGARDING THE GOODS WHICH ARE BEING SOLD "AS IS."

BUYER AGREES THAT BUYER'S SOLE REMEDY AND SELLER'S SOLE LIABILITY FOR BREACH OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS CONTRACT SHALL BE TO REFUND THE PURCHASE PRICE OF THIS CONTRACT OR REPLACEMENT OF THE GOODS. BUYER ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT BUYER WAIVES ALL RIGHTS TO CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES WHICH MAY ARISE FROM THIS CONTRACT, MISDESCRIPTION, OR INADEQUACY OF THE GOODS.

THE PLANT MATERIAL:

- Seller is using the highest standards to provide premium grapevines. All vines have a solid graft union, vigorous shoot, and a well-established root system.
- All dormant benchgrafts and rootings are trimmed.
- There are 25 vines per bundle with identification for the variety, clone, and rootstock.

BUYERS RIGHT TO INSPECTION:

Buyer, after providing Seller with reasonable notice and at Buyer's sole expense, has the right to inspect the goods at any given time during the growing season or after the goods have been graded. After such inspection, Buyer's failure to deliver a written claim to seller within five (5) days of the inspection shall be deemed irrevocable acceptance of the goods, and an admission by Buyer that the goods fully comply with all the terms and conditions in this contract. Except as stated herein, Buyer waives any rights under Section 2513 of the UCC.

CIRCUMSTANCES EXCUSING SELLER'S PERFORMANCE:

Seller shall have no liability for delay or failure to ship any goods subject to this contract if such delay or failure is due to "Acts of God," (e.g., strikes, accidents, weather conditions, performance of material (scion wood/rootstock), fire, and regulations imposed by governmental agencies), or circumstances beyond the reasonable control of Seller. If Buyer cancels this Agreement for reasons other than default by Seller, Seller shall retain the deposit and all progress payments received prior to cancellation in addition to all other legal and equitable remedies. If Seller locates a Buyer for the Grapevines which Seller is not obligated to do, and if sale occurs and Seller actually receives payment which exceeds the contract price plus additional expenses (including, without limitation, cost of locating another buyer, accruing interest, attorney's fees, extra delivery cost, etc.), then Seller will refund to Buyer any funds which exceed the contract. Notwithstanding the above, Seller Shall be entitled to retain all payments advanced by Buyer until such mitigating sales proceeds are received, and all expenses are calculated. Any refund shall be without interest and shall not exceed the amount actually paid by Buyer.

INTEGRATION:

This contract constitutes the full agreement of the parties, superseding all prior representations or agreements, oral or written, regarding the goods.

MODIFICATIONS:

This contract constitutes the entire agreement between parties and may not be altered, modified, or rescinded except in writing signed by each party hereto.

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WAIVER:

Waiver by either party of a breach by other party of any term hereof shall not be considered a waiver of any other term or any subsequent breach of the same term.

ASSIGNMENT AND SUCCESSORS:

This contract shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of heirs, representatives, successors and assign of the parties hereto.

AMBIGUITY:

Each party acknowledges and agrees that this contract has been negotiated and prepared jointly by each party and that in the event of ambiguity, it shall not be construed against either party, but rather each term herein shall be given a reasonable interpretation.

ATTORNEYS' FEES.:

In the event legal proceedings are brought by either party to enforce any term, covenant or condition in this contract, the prevailing party in such proceeding shall be entitled to recover all costs, including reasonable attorneys' fees.

STORAGE:

Seller will store the goods through June_of shipping year at no charge. Please be advised Seller does not recommend planting dormant vines after June 1 and will not be held responsible for poor performance of grapevines as a result of late season planting.

CHOICE OF LAW AND VENUE:

Parties specifically agree that this contract shall be in accordance with California law, and should any action be brought upon this contract venue shall be laid in Sutter County, California, and that the last act to make this contract enforceable occurred in Sutter County, California.

GRAPEVINE NURSERY ASSESSMENT:

California Fruit & Nut Tree & Grapevine Improvement Assessment is 1% and shall be assessed in accordance with law. This assessment is taxable.

FINANCE CHARGE:

Finance charge of 1.5 % per month (18 % per year) will be charged for all amount unpaid thirty (30) days from due date. Where an invoice or bill is sent, such a finance charge will be assessed for the amount due if not paid within 30 days of the date of invoice/bill.
