Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On May 3, 2019, CITY OF PRINEVILLE filed an application to change the points of appropriation under Certificates 22839, 83993, 86889, 86337, 15539 and 86558. The Department assigned the application number T-13176.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on May 14, 2019, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On October 28, 2019, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13176 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of November 27, 2019 for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

19. Municipal water rights are not subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.

- 20. A pump and pipeline system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-13176.
- 21. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 22. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 23. All other application requirements are met.

Determination and Proposed Action

The change in points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-13176 appears to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the application will be approved.

If Transfer Application T-13176 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- 1. The change in points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-13176 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 22839, 83993, 86889, 86337, 15539, 86558 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right Certificates 22839, 83993, 86889, 86337, 15539, 86558 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing those portions of the rights not affected by this transfer.
- 4. The quantity of water diverted under the right described by Certificate 22839 at the new point of appropriation (Yancey Well 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (Yancey Well 1).
- 5. The quantity of water diverted under the right described by Certificate 83993 at the new point of appropriation (Yancey Well 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (Stearns Well #2 and Barney Well).
- 6. The quantity of water diverted under the right described by Certificate 86889 at the new point of appropriation (Yancey Well 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (4th Street Deep Well).
- 7. The quantity of water diverted under the right described by Certificate 86337 at the new point of appropriation (Yancey Well 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (LaMonta Well).
- 8. The quantity of water diverted under the right described by Certificate 15539 at the new point of appropriation (Yancey Well 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (10th Street Well).

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- 9. The quantity of water diverted under the right described by Certificate 86558 at the new point of appropriation (Yancey Well 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (Ochoco Heights Well No. 1).
- 10. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each new point of appropriation.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 11. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
- 12. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2025**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 13. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.

A public notice is being published in the Department's weekly publication and in the Central Oregonian newspaper, simultaneously with issuance of the Preliminary Determination. The notice initiates a period in which any person may file either a protest opposing the decision proposed by the Department in the Preliminary Determination or a standing statement supporting the Department's decision. The protest period will end 30 days after the last date of newspaper publication.

If no protest is filed, the Department will issue a Final Order consistent with the Preliminary Determination. You should receive a copy of the Final Order about 30 days after the close of the protest period.

If a protest is filed, the application may be referred to a contested case proceeding. A contested case provides an opportunity for the proponents and opponents of the decision proposed in the Preliminary Determination to present information and arguments supporting their position in a quasi-judicial proceeding.
