Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On June 26, 2017, Scott Tobiasson and Jose Tobiasson filed an application to change the points of appropriation and to change the places of use under Certificates 28570, 90483, 48610, 90485, 80437 and 63583. The Department assigned the application number T-12704.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on August 4, 2017, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. This transfer, along with T-12708 (Simmons) proposes to modify Certificate 90485 and should be processed together simultaneously.
- 4. On November 13, 2018, and December 10, 2018, the Department received revised application pages and maps clarifying the places of use and points of appropriation descriptions.

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, any person may file a protest or standing statement within 30 days after the last date of publication of notice of this preliminary determination.

- 5. On December 13, 2018, the Department issued a draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-12704. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of January 13, 2019, for the applicant to respond. On January 18, 2019, the agent for the applicant agreed to the terms and conditions of the draft Preliminary Determination, requested the Department proceed with issuance of the Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

- 24. Water has been used within the last five years prior to the submittal of Transfer Application T-12704 according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 25. Several wells, pumps, pipeline infrastructure, center pivots and sprinkler systems sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-12704.
- 26. The Department has determined that the proposed wells Albertsen Well #1 (LAKE 377), and POA #6 (LAKE 126) both develop the same source of water as the authorized existing points of appropriation. Under OAR 690-380-2110, any request for a change in (or additional) point of appropriation is restricted to the same aquifer.
- 27. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 28. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 29. All other application requirements are met.

Determination and Proposed Action

The changes in points of appropriation and places of use proposed in Transfer Application T-12704 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the application will be approved.

If Transfer Application T-12704 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- 1. The changes in points of appropriation and places of use proposed in Transfer Application T-12704 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 28570, 90483, 48610, 90485, 80437 and 63583 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right Certificates 28570, 90483, 48610, 90485, 80437 and 63583 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing those portions of the rights not affected by this transfer. This transfer, along with T-12708 (Simmons) proposes to modify Certificate 90485 and should be processed together simultaneously:
- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation shall not exceed the quantities of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.

- 5. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 6. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
- 7. The former places of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water under the rights.
- 8. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2021**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 9. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.

Please find enclosed the Preliminary Determination indicating that, based on the information available, the Department intends to approve application T-12704. This document is an intermediate step in the approval process; water may not be used legally as proposed in the transfer application until a Final Order has been issued by the Department. Please read this entire letter carefully to determine your responsibility for additional action.

A public notice is being published in the Department's weekly publication and in the Lake County Examiner newspaper, simultaneously with issuance of the Preliminary Determination. The notice initiates a period in which any person may file either a protest opposing the decision proposed by the Department in the Preliminary Determination or a standing statement supporting the Department's decision. The protest period will end 30 days after the last date of newspaper publication.

If no protest is filed, the Department will issue a Final Order consistent with the Preliminary Determination. You should receive a copy of the Final Order about 30 days after the close of the protest period.

If a protest is filed, the application may be referred to a contested case proceeding. A contested case provides an opportunity for the proponents and opponents of the decision proposed in the Preliminary Determination to present information and arguments supporting their position in a quasi-judicial proceeding.
