- *Example for Line 3a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Certificate 12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Certificate 87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:
- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac = 0.56 cfs).
 - b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Add cfs for the portions of water rights on all the land included in the transfer; however do not count cfs for supplemental rights on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary right on the same land. The fee should be assessed only once for each "on the ground" acre included in the transfer. (In this example, blank 3a would be only 0.56 cfs, since both rights serve the same 45.0 acres. Blank 3b would be 0 and Line 3 would then also become 0).

The Water Resources Department requires applicants intending to file an application to transfer a water right to instream purposes to notify local governments that could be affected, so that the local government can make sure that the proposed new use does not result in a land use that would be incompatible with its comprehensive plan.

As such, we are notifying you that we intend to submit an application to the Oregon Water Resources Department proposing to transfer a portion of water right Certificate 68109 to instream use. The proposed place of instream use would be at the authorized point of diversion located in Township 10S, Range 2W, Section 10, NE ½ NW ½ on Smallman Creek near the mouth where it enters the North Santiam River.
