IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF MIN HILLIS FOR CHANGE IN THE PLACE OF USE OF MATER UPON HIS LANDS LOCATED IN SECTIONS 11 and 12 TOWNSHIPT 35 SOUTH RANGE FOUR WEST OF WILLAMETTE LERIDIAN JACKSON COUNTY OREGON UNDER DECREED MATER RICHT GRANTED IN THE DECREE TO THE WATER OF ROGUE RIVER DATED APRIL 26, 1919.

APPLICATION FOR CHANGE IN DIACE OF USE OF WATER.

Comes now William Hillis who is the owner of a decreed water right to 1.49 second feet of water for the irrigation of 89 acres of land located in sections 11 and 12. Townshipt 35 South Range four West of Willamette Meridian Jackson County Oregon, under a decree duly made given and entered in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Jackson, In the matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Waters of Rugue River, and its Tributaries, on April 26, 1919, decreeing said water and water right to the said William Hillis out of the waters of Evans Creek, a tributary of Rogue River, through the Feilder or Hillis ditch, with a date of priority of the year 1881, and applies to the State Engineer of the State of Oregon for a change in the place of use of that portion of the said decreed waters decreed to him to be used upon ten acres of land located in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter, of Section eleven. Townshipt 35 South of Range four: West of Willamette Meridian, Jackson County Oregon, so that the same may be used by the said William Hillis upon the said Twenty acres of land in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said section eleven and twenty eight acres of land in the Northeast Quarter of Northwest Quarter, and twenty two scree of land in the Southwest Quarter of Horthwest Quarter of Section twelve Townshipt 35 South of Range four West of Willamette Meridian, under which he has a water right under the said decree.

That no water from Evans Creek has been used upon the said ten acres of land in said section eleven for more than twenty year last past, and no waters have been used upon the said ten acres

through the said Feilder or Hillis ditch for more than twenty years That the said Villiam Hillis has with the permission last past. of the water master of the State of Oregon for Jackson County since said State and County has had a watermaster, and for more than twenty years last past, used the said 1.49 second feet of water so decreed to him from the waters of Evens Creek, upon the other lands herein decribed, and upon which he has a water right under said decree. That for more then twenty years last past the said William Hillis has been and now is in open, notorious, hostile, exclusive, and adverse possession of said water and using the same and placing the same upon and with said water irrigating the said lands of William That the said William Hillis, in said sections eleven and twelve. Hillis does not now, and none of his predecessors have ever owned the said ten acres of land in said section eleven, and none of the said 1.49 second feet of water decreed to William Hillis is appurtenant to the said ten acres, but is appurtenant to and has been used upon and is appurtenant to the other land of William Hillis described herein and in said decree, upon which William Hillis has That said water so decreed to William Hillis a decreed water right. to be used upon the said ten acres of land in said section eleven is necessary to and must be used upon the other lands of William Hillis herein described in order that crops be raised thereon as have been That for more than twenty years last past no other in the past. claimant or water user has used or attempted to use the said water decreed to the said Hillis upon any other land than the land now owned That water cannot be conveyed to the said ten acres of by Hillis. land in said section eleven with/cementing the ditch of Hillis, or great damage will be done to the land of Hillis, through seepage. That the said Hillis is the exclusive owner of the said ditch, and no one has the right to pass water through the same except Hillis.

WHEREFORE, the said William Hillis prays that the State
Engineer grants the application of applicant and changes the place of
use of the water decreed to the said Hillis to be used upon the said
ten acres in section eleven, so that the applicant may use the same

upon the lands of applicant William Hillis herein described, and that the state engineer set a time and place for the hearing of this application, and give notice thereof, and the place of the hearing be set in Medford Jackson County Oregon.
