1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:

a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs ÷100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).

b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

The 533.23 acres of water right are irrigated using three 50-hp centrifugal pumps and two Echo 125 travelers with booster pumps. The following describes where the pumps and travelers have been used in the last 5 years and the related system capacities.

<u>POD 2</u> – This POD is proposed to be added to the water right by this application. The system capacity is 1.35 cfs as follows:

Water is diverted from the POD using a portable 50-hp centrifugal Berkeley pump rated for 650 gpm. The lift from the river to the pump is approximately 10 feet and the system pressure is reported to be 90 psi. The WRD online calculator for CWREs indicates the pump produces 1.38 cfs (approximately 619 gpm).
