 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).

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Description of Water Delivery System

System capacity: <u>0.6</u> cubic feet per second (cfs) **OR**gallons per minute (gpm)

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Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Include information on the pumps, canals, pipelines, and sprinklers used to divert, convey, and apply the water at the authorized place of use. Stored water from a Willamette Basin Project Reservoir is released into the Willamette River during the irrigation season to fulfill BOR contract No. 119E101760. Palmer Creek Water District Improvement Company pumps the water using one to three vertical-turbine pumps with an ODFW approved fish screen on the intake. A fish bypass device is not applicable with this configuration. The number of pumps used is based on demand. Total system capacity is 20,000 gpm. Water flows from the pumps through 1,400 feet of 36-inch steel and then 36-inch concrete pipe to an unlined canal that carries the water 3 miles to a tributary of Palmer Creek. A 75 hp pump is used to redivert the water from Palmer Creek and is piped to Alderman reservoir through a 6-inch mainline. A 40 hp pump sends water from Alderman reservoir to Unionvale reservoir through a 12-inch and 10-inch mainline or directly to the field through 12-inch, 10-inch, 8-inch and 6-inch mainlines. A 40 hp pump delivers the water from Unionvale reservoir to the place of use. Water is applied to the field using either a 150 Nelson hard hose traveler (1.0-inch nozzle) operated at 115 psi using a booster pump on the traveler or handlines at 70 psi. Irrigation method used to apply water is based on type of crop and best management practices.


