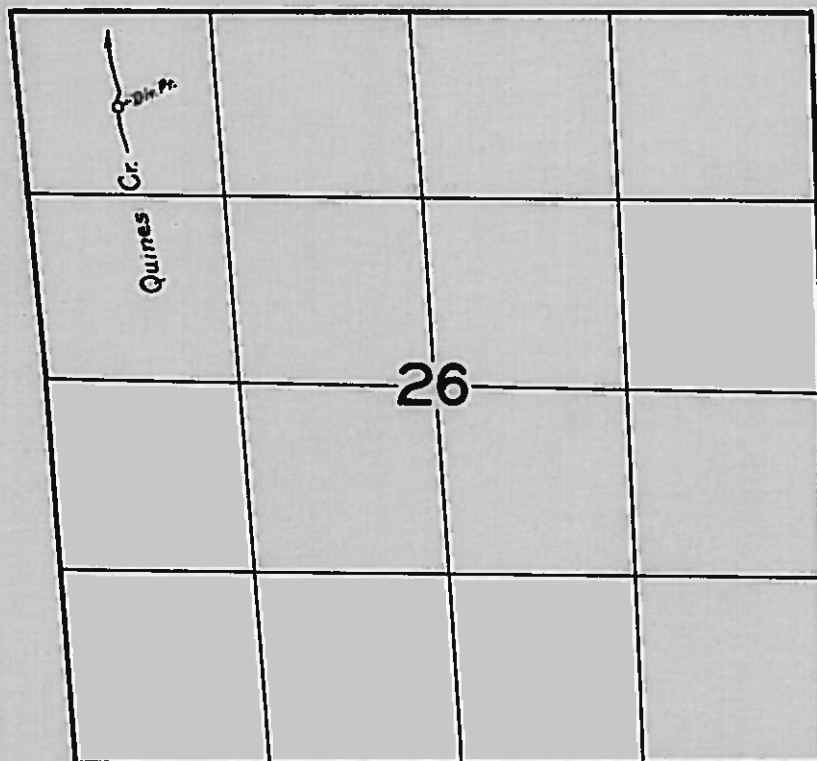

O R D E R  
APPROVING APPLICATION

On June 21, 1957, Shirley D. Palmer of Quines Creek Road, Glendale, Oregon, filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Quines Creek pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The findings of fact and order of determination of the State Engineer in the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Cow Creek and its tributaries, as confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court for Douglas County, Oregon, entered August 14, 1930, established a water right in the name of J. W. Haight for domestic and stock use and the irrigation of 3.2 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W. M., from Quines Creek with a date of priority of 1893 through the Blinn ditch. The point of diversion of the Blinn ditch is located 10 feet south and 1100 feet east from the southwest corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26, and being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , said Section 26, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The applicant herein, owner of the land above described, proposes to change the point of diversion of water for domestic and stock use and the irrigation of said land to a portable pumping unit to be located on applicant's land along Quines Creek between a point 500 feet north and 700 feet east from the southwest corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W. M., and a point extending downstream a distance of 500 feet, and being within the said NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed

change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Roseburg, Oregon, on September 5, 1957, beginning at 10:00 o'clock a.m. The notice was published in the Roseburg News Review, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Douglas County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of July 12, 19 and 26, 1957. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mt. George Thrasher, Watermaster of District No. 16, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Quines Creek may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Quines Creek, to-wit:

From a point located 10 feet south and 1100 feet east from the southwest corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26, and being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , said Section 26, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W. M.,

To a portable pumping unit to be located on applicant's lands along Quines Creek between a point 500 feet north and 700 feet east from the southwest corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W. M., and a point extending downstream a distance of 500 feet, and being within the said NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26,

for domestic and stock use and the irrigation of 3.2 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W. M., with a date of priority of 1893, be and the same is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water that is available at the old point of diversion.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1958



or within such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the pumping plant and related works shall include a weir or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the plans of the weir or other suitable device be approved by the watermaster of Josephine County, Oregon, before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

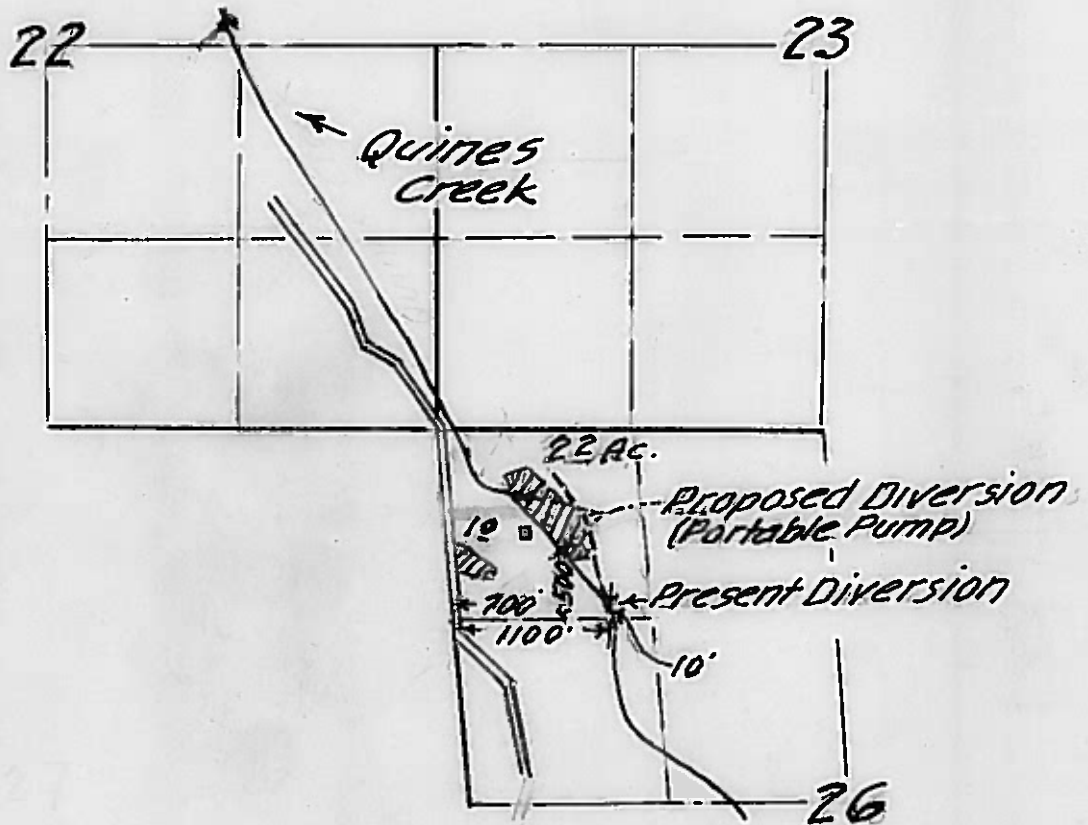
