- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).

Description of Water Delivery System System capacity: 4.25 cubic feet per second (cfs) OR gallons per minute (gpm) Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. The well (Lake 2820) supplies water for Certificates 87093 and 95027. The pump in the well is a 75 hp turbine that produces 1907 GPM. This well supplies two pivots and the pivot corners are irrigated using hand line. Also, part of the area is flood irrigated. We use aluminum mainline from the buried mainline between the two pivots.






