I operate a 100 pair cow calf operation in Lee Valley, just East of Myrtle Point, Oregon and have applied for cost share assistance from the USDA through the environmental quality incentives program. I have been working with Tom Purvis in the Coquille office to develop a total farm management program which will still allow for an efficient sensible farming operation, but provide for a positive impact to the total environmental due to our ranching operations.

I have recently requested a waiver (see enclosed) to allow me to begin the installation of a permanent buried mainline and permanent buried two inch trough watering system which will be used to apply irrigation water and cattle drinking water from the North Fork of the Coquille River to our summer pasturelands prior to the anticipated fall approval of our contract by the Farm Service Agency Committee. I think this waiver will allow us to gain a year on the negative impact associated with our current method of irrigation and cattle watering. More specifically, I will have to allow my cow-calf pairs to water directly from the river even though the river banks have just been completely fenced and will have to install four pumps @ four different diversion points for irrigating pastures versus one permanent irrigation pump and no cattle up and down my permanently fenced banks. I currently am pasturing this property through May 15th. I will pull the cattle off May 15th until hay season (approx. July 1st-15th). Shortly thereafter, I will need to start irrigation and pasture through November 15th.

I have not started the installation of the pipeline, and am aware that I must wait for consideration of a waiver to remain eligible for the financial assistance, and will not use water from the new point prior to your formal decision on this matter. Tom Purvis has communicated the requirement for this pipeline installation in accordance with NCRS standards and specifications and will be sharing all plans and specifications with me prior to installation to meet his approval.
