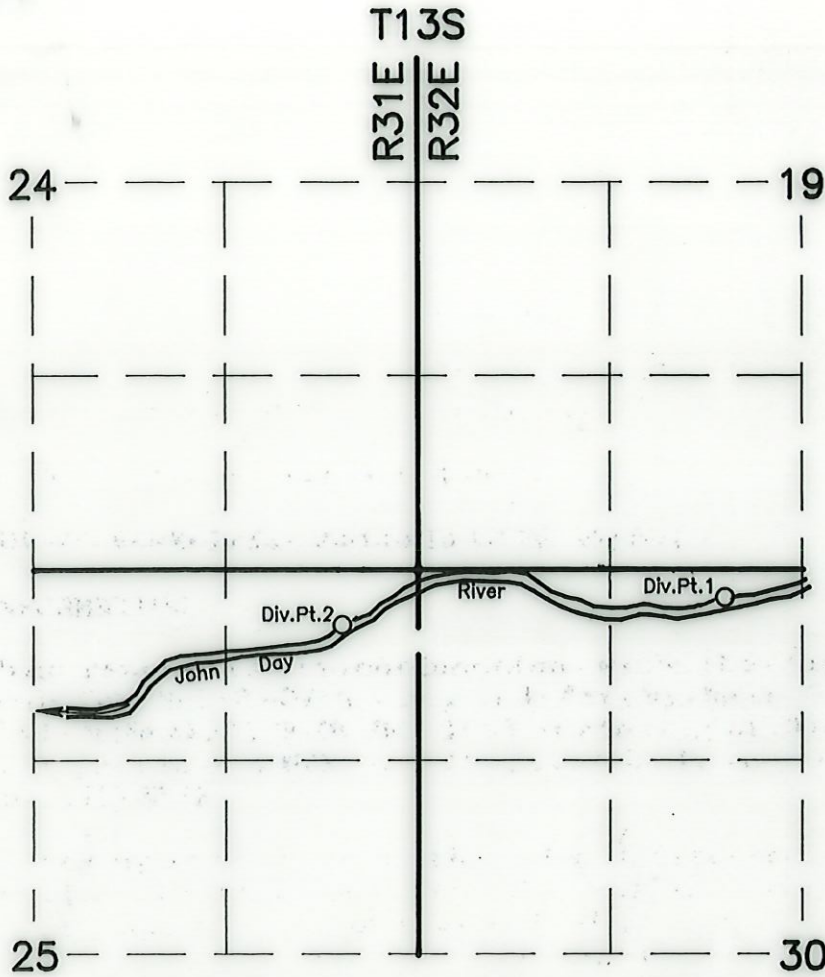

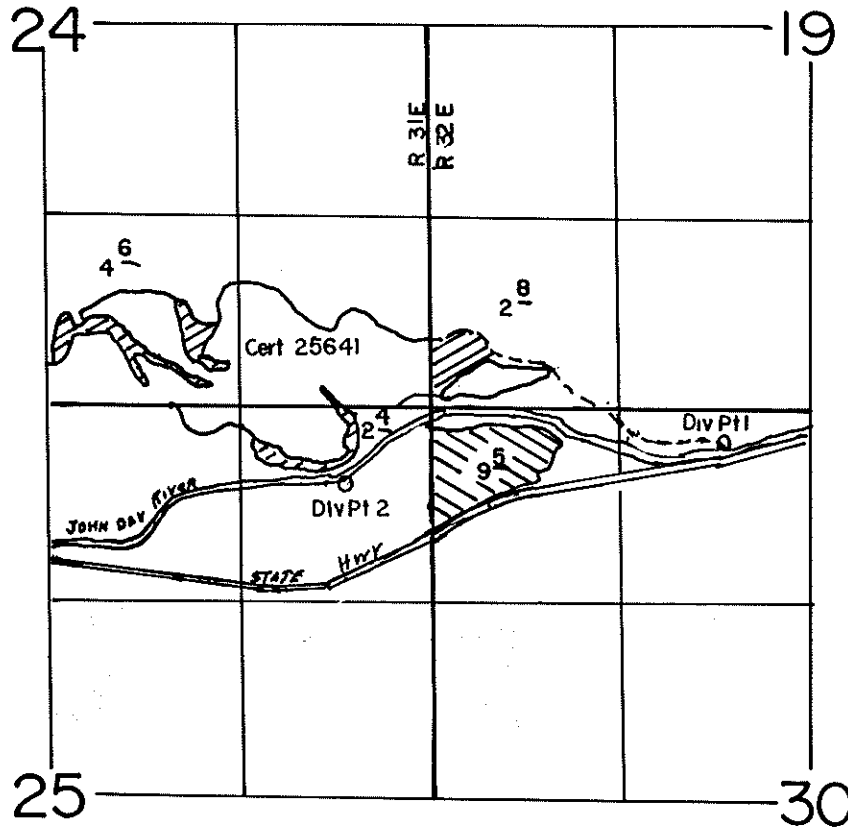

ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6564 submitted by

NEAL J. AND ANNA DOW

PRAIRIE CITY, OREGON 97869.

The first right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT County as evidenced by Certificate 25641. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1868.

The right allows the use of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 46.2 ACRES. This right is limited to 1/40 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE IRRIGATED FROM APRIL 1 TO SEPTEMBER 30; FURTHER LIMITED TO ONE ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE PER CALENDAR MONTH TO JULY 1 AND 3/4 ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE THEREAFTER; TOTAL FIVE ACRE-FEET PER ACRE FOR THE SEASON ~~cubic foot per second~~, if available at the authorized points of diversion: Fred Miller and Trowbridge Ditches, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The applicant proposes to add an additional point of diversion to:

The applicant also proposes to eliminate the Trowbridge Ditch from the 1868 right.

THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificates 25641 and ~~65532~~ are cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the rights NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.

NOTICE OF CERTIFICATE ISSUANCE

Attached is a certificate that confirms the water right established under the terms of a transfer order issued by this department. The water right is now appurtenant to the specific place where the use was established as described by the certificate. The owner of the land is the owner of the water right. The water right is limited to a specific amount of water, but not more than can be beneficially used for the purposes stated within the certificate.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within **60 days of the mailing date stated above** as specified by ORS 183.484(2).

This statement of judicial review rights is required under ORS 536.075; it does not alter or add to existing review rights or create review rights that are not otherwise provided by law.

Oregon law does not allow the Director to reissue a certificate because of a change in the ownership. The water must be controlled and not wasted. To change the location of the point of diversion, the character of use, or the location of use requires the advance approval of the Water Resources Director.

If any portion of this water right is not used for five or more consecutive years, that portion of the right may be subject to forfeiture according to ORS 540.610. Land enrolled in a Federal Reserve Program is not subject to forfeiture during the period of enrollment. Other exceptions to forfeiture are explained in ORS 540.610.

T-6564 was a transfer for an additional pod for all of the primary lands under P-48178, C-65532. Remaining rights C-67794 was issued for the supplemental lands. C-65532 was cancelled.

T-6710 was a transfer for change in use, pou and pod. Part of this transfer is for the supplemental lands now under C-67794 but identifies it as C-65532 on page 2, (already superceeded by C-67794). Thus this transfer incorrectly cancels C-65532 on page 4. ✓

C-67941 is a remaining rights certificate that was issued as a result of T-6710. This is an error because they are the same primary lands being transferred under T-6564 and those lands could not have been proven up on yet. ✓

T-6564, Sp. Or. V. 46, P. 452 has an error in the sixth line of the fourth paragraph. It states cubic feet per second in the area it is explaining acre feet per season. ✓

INFORMATION :

This report is in conjunction with the final proof survey for Transfer No. T-6564, applied for by Neal Dow, the new owner is William McNeil, P.O. Box 1056, Orinda, CA., 94563. The ranch manager is Allan Mullin HCR 77 Box 131, John Day, Oregon, 97845, Telephone No. 575-2152.

During my inspection of the site, I discussed the system with Allan Mullin. He informed me of the general operation of the system and showed me the site location, the point of diversion, the pump and motor, the main line, and the sprinkler pipe used in sprinkling operations.

The source of the water used is from the John Day River, a tributary of the Columbia River.

This additional point of diversion is located on the north bank of the John Day River. The diversion of water is accomplished by means of a General Electric, 25 horse, 230/460V, 3 phase, 3540 RPM, electric motor and a Cornell centrifugal pump, Model No. 2½Y25-2. The motor is mounted on a wood plank frame. The pump has 3 inch intake and 3 inch outlet pipes.

The main line is constructed of buried, 5 inch steel pipe, and runs northerly from the river point of diversion for 880 feet to the north side of a field. I counted 10 risers in the main line.

From a riser a 3½ inch wheel line ran west for 2130 feet, and a 3" aluminum hand line ran north for 800 feet through the west part of the west field.

From another riser in the main line a 3 inch aluminum hand line ran east for 1360 feet.

The system was operating on the day of my inspection, I counted 76 sprinkler heads irrigating an alfalfa crop in the west and east fields.

A Maximum amount of 76 sprinklers heads are used in sprinkling the fields. The sprinkler heads are marked Rainbird 30 or Nelson. The operator uses 3/16 inch nozzles.

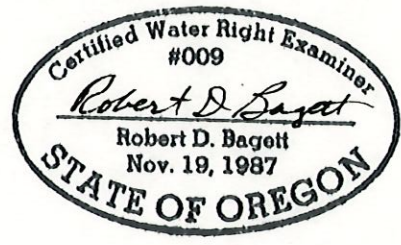
The use of the water on the date of inspection was for crop irrigation, specifically, for alfalfa.

The difference in elevation between the source and use of the water on the field varies from + 4 feet to +8 feet.

The point of diversion is tied to a 2½ inch diameter iron pipe, BLM monument of record, marking the NE corner Section 25, Twp. 13 S., R.31 E., W.M. This survey was conducted with a Wild TC1600 total station electronic measuring device.

At this time it is my observation that the conditions of the transfer have been met. The system is in place and is capable of being used as applied for, with exceptions, as noted above.

The final proof survey and inspection of the use as, found to be completed under the terms and conditions of Transfer T-6564 was completed by me on August 12, 1994, and the facts contained in this report and accompanying final proof map are correct to the best of my knowledge.

You are required to hire a certified water right examiner (CWRE) to complete a Claim of Beneficial Use which must be submitted to this department by October 1, 1994. The Claim of Beneficial Use must include a map and site report prepared by the CWRE and signed by both the CWRE and the land owner. Enclosed is a list of CWRE's. Also enclosed is a copy of the order which approved Transfer 6564 and the application map for your CWRE's use.

You may claim only the beneficial use authorized and developed within the terms of the order. Any part of the use that was not completed will be excluded from the certificate of water right which will ultimately be issued to you.

The Department requires that the CWRE has a copy of the permit or transfer order to compile the claim of beneficial use. All permit conditions need to be addressed in the claim and map you submit.

In the meantime, the transfer order will be evidence of your right to the use of water provided you continue to use the water for the purpose authorized.
