**Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Certificate 12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Certificate 87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:*

- For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:
 - Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (*for C12345, 1.25 cfs ÷ 100 ac*); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs ($\times 45 \text{ ac} = 0.56 \text{ cfs}$).
 - If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (*For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs*)

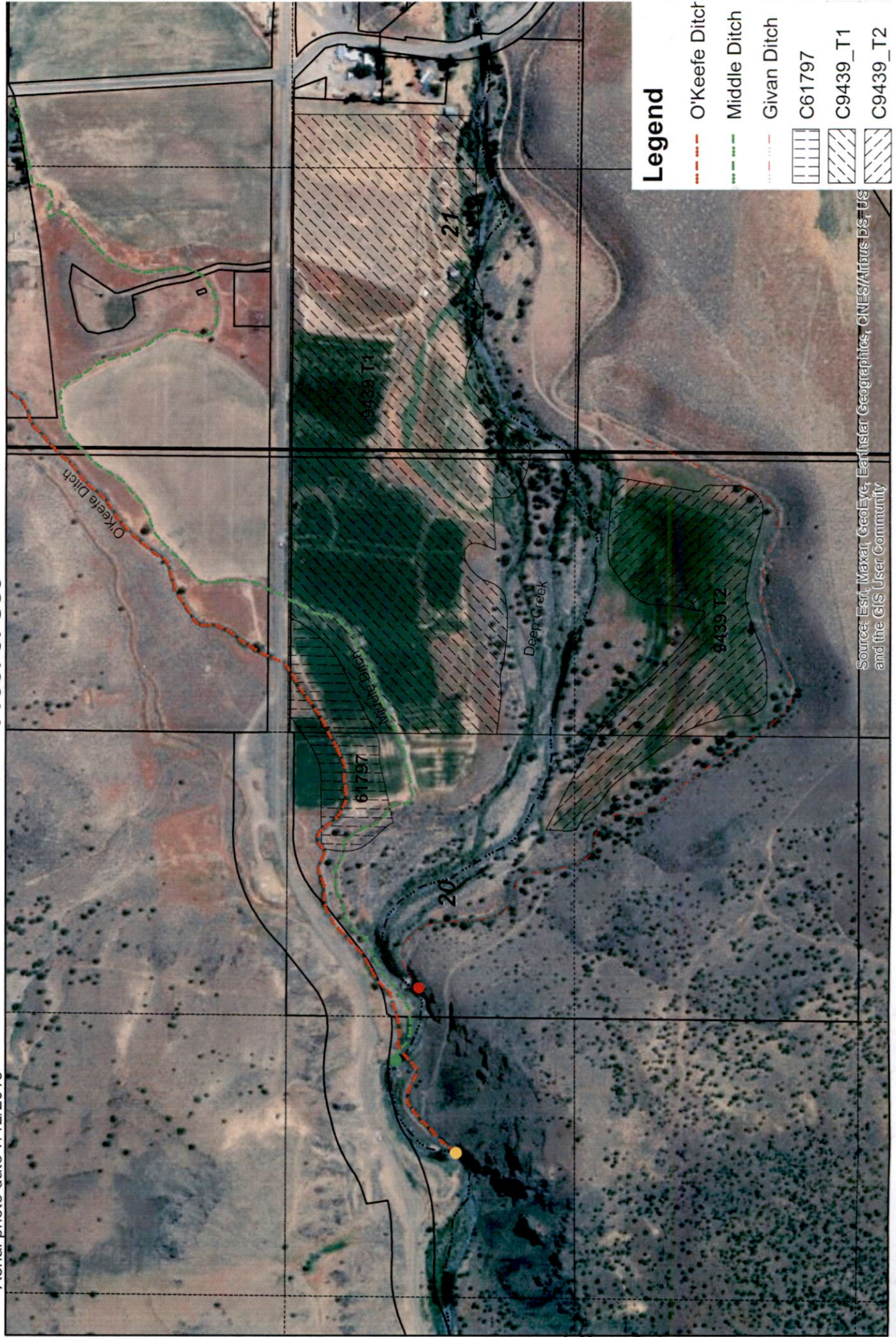

Hollie and Troy,

ODFW has assessed the information provided for the proposed transfers of Certificates 9439, 61797, 9428, and 66882 on Deep Creek near Adel, Oregon. Our assessment is in regards to the changes providing a net benefit to fish and wildlife habitat in order to qualify for a fee reduction offered through the Oregon Water Resources Department.

It is ODFW's understanding that the 3 diversions involved in the transfer are being updated, in part, to provide fish passage and screening meeting ODFW's criteria. Final fish screening and passage authorizations have yet to be obtained from ODFW, but we have been actively working with the project proponents to restore fish passage in Deep Creek.

For these transfers, the middle diversion (POD 2), which is currently a complete barrier to fish passage at most flows, will be removed and water use will be transferred upstream to the uppermost diversion (POD 1). The uppermost diversion (POD 1) will be equipped with fish passage meeting ODFW's criteria and already has criteria fish screening. The lowermost diversion (POD 3) will also be removed as part of the project and water use will be transferred downstream to a new pump station (POD 4) equipped with a criteria fish screen. ODFW understands that the new POD 4 will not include an artificial obstruction to fish passage.

When considered as a package, ODFW has determined that the proposed transfers provide a change that will result in a net benefit to fish and wildlife habitat and qualify for OWRD's fee reduction.
