SUBJECT: Water Right Transfer Application T-13496

Please find enclosed the Preliminary Determination indicating that, based on the information available, the Department intends to approve application T-13496. This document is an intermediate step in the approval process; water may not be used legally as proposed in the transfer application until a Final Order has been issued by the Department. Please read this entire letter carefully to determine your responsibility for additional action.

A public notice is being published in the Department's weekly publication and in the Klamath Falls Herald and News newspaper, simultaneously with issuance of the Preliminary Determination. The notice initiates a period in which any person may file either a protest opposing the decision proposed by the Department in the Preliminary Determination or a standing statement supporting the Department's decision. The protest period will end 30 days after the last date of newspaper publication.

If no protest is filed, the Department will issue a Final Order consistent with the Preliminary Determination. You should receive a copy of the Final Order about 30 days after the close of the protest period.

If a protest is filed, the application may be referred to a contested case proceeding. A contested case provides an opportunity for the proponents and opponents of the decision proposed in the Preliminary Determination to present information and arguments supporting their position in a quasi-judicial proceeding.

# Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

## **Findings of Fact**

- 1. On July 23, 2020, DEBORAH ANN WALLACE filed an application for an additional point of appropriation, a change in points of appropriation, and to change the place of use under Certificate 91588. The Department assigned the application number T-13496.
- 2. On July 23, 2020, the applicant's agent sent an Affidavit for the Voluntary Partial Diminution of a Water Right Permit to the Department for Certificate 91588 for 125.0 acres.
- 3. Notice of the application for transfer was published on August 4, 2020, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 4. On November 20, 2020, the Department contacted the agent requesting a new Affidavit of Partial Diminution (Affidavit) listing the "FROM" lands.
- 5. On November 30, 2020, the applicant's agent emailed a map of the "FROM" lands being diminished.

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, any person may file a protest or standing statement within 30 days after the last date of publication of notice of this preliminary determination.

- 6. On December 2, 2020, the Department replied to the agent and requested a new Affidavit listing the "FROM" lands and signed by the owner of the "FROM" lands.
- 7. On February 24, 2021, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13496 to the applicants. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of March 26, 2021, for the applicants to respond. The applicants requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
- 8. The right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 91588 in the name of RANDOLPH WALLACE AND DEBORAH

WALLACE (perfected under Permit G-12979)

Use: IRRIGATION of 311.5 ACRES

Priority Date: OCTOBER 22, 1993

Rate: 2.48 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

Limit/Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the

amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the

irrigation season of each year.

**Period of Use:** MARCH 1 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30 **Source:** A WELL in the LOST RIVER BASIN

### Partial Diminution of a Water Right

13. The proposed place of use that is described in FOF #12 has a pre-existing water right for primary irrigation under Claim KA-1000. On July 14, 2020, Arnott Duncan and Kathleen A. Duncan, Managers of Aguila G-Boys LK 300 LLC, requested to diminish the lands for the new place of use under Certificate 91588 to Supplemental Irrigation. The portion of the right to be diminished as follows:

Certificate: 91588 in the name of RANDOLPH WALLACE (perfected under Permit

G-12979)

Use: IRRIGATION of 125.0 ACRES

Priority Date: OCTOBER 22, 1993

Rate: 1.00 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

**Limit/Duty:** The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the

amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the

irrigation season of each year.

**Period of Use:** MARCH 1 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30 **Source:** A WELL in the LOST RIVER BASIN

# Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

- 14. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 15. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-13496.
- 16. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.

- 17. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 18. All other application requirements are met.

## **Determination and Proposed Action**

The additional points of appropriation, change in point of appropriation, and change in places of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13496 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the application will be approved.

If Transfer Application T-13496 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- 1. The additional point of appropriation, change in points of appropriation, and change in places of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13496 are approved. The portion of the right proposed to be diminished is diminished.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 91588 and any related decree.
- Water right Certificate 91588 is cancelled.
- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, (We'll #2), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (Well #1), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (Well #1).
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation, (Well #3, Well #4, Well #5, and Well #6), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (Well #1).
- 6. Water use measurement conditions:
  - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation, (new and existing).
  - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
  - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 7. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
- 8. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.

- 9. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2022**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 10. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
