This right was perfected under Permit U-353. The date of priority is JULY 26, 1950. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.47 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original point of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.


