



- The map should be of sufficient quality to be reproducible. Please do not use highlighters to mark items on the map as highlighters do not always copy.
- A North arrow and map scale (no smaller than 1'' = 1320').
- Township, Range, Section, quarter quarter (QQ), and a clearly labeled survey corner.
- For irrigation or other similar use, the number of acres to be leased in each quarter-quarter clearly labeled and hatchured to differentiate between the acres being leased and any remaining. 




CERTIFICATE 16900 - PRIORITY: 12/15/1944 PRIMARY IRRIGATION 13.6 acres





During those years I grew a combination of wheat, red clover forage, and red clover seed on the land.


To support crop production, I exercised and utilized water rights consistent with Certificate Nos. 16900, 22091, and 27473 which benefit the property.
