





USE OF C-22998 WATER RIGHT IN RECENT YEARS HAS BEEN PRECLUDED DUE TO ECONOMIC HARDSHIP IN APPLICATION OF WATER RIGHT CONSISTENT WITH THE TERMS OF THE CERTIFICATE. PREVIOUS OWNER OF RIGHTS TRANSFERRED POD OF C-22998 IN EARLY-1980s (T-5161) TO ALLOW PUMPING FROM A DOWNSTREAM POD ON KNUTZEN GULCH. THE PREVIOUS OWNER SUBSEQUENTLY CANCELED T-5161 IN 1989 DUE TO DIFFICULTIES ENCOUNTERED WITH PUMPING TO IRRIGATION FROM NEW POD. CURRENT OWNER WAS NOT AWARE OF T-5161 CANCELLATION AND IN RECENT YEARS TRIED TO OPERATE A PUMP FROM THE DIVERSION POINT ON LOWER KNUTZEN GULCH. UNSUCCESSFUL IN HIS ATTEMPTS AT THAT LOCATION, THE CURRENT OWNER INVESTIGATED RESUSCITATION OF THE TRAMMEL-BIEBERSTEDT DITCH FROM THE AUTHORIZED POD ON UPPER KNUTZEN GULCH TO HIS PROPERTY. THIS EFFORT WAS ABANDONED DUE TO THE EXPENSE OF CLEANING UP THE 5000+ FEET OF DITCH WITH ELEVATION DROP OF ~60 FEET AND THE NECESSITY OF SECURING EASEMENTS THROUGH TAX LOTS OF TWO NEIGHBORING LANDOWNERS TO FACILITATE USE OF THE DITCH						

Precedent: If a right which has been leased is later proposed to be leased again or later transferred or become part of an allocation of conserved water project, a new injury review shall be required. An instream lease shall not set a precedent on a future transaction.

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
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



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This Is to Certify, That DONALD BIEBERSTELT

of P. O. Box 6. Eagle Point , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Little Butte Creek and Knutzen Gulch and reservoir constructed under Application to a tributary of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 20560 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 13. 1951.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NE₄SE₄. Section 32. Township 35 South. Range 1 East. W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $4\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1222,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.2 acres in the SW\(\frac{1}{4}\)Section 32

Township 35 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

1.8 acres in the SE\(\frac{1}{4}\)Section 31
