The water delivery system used by Norpac involved holding ponds that were a mix of processing wastewater and water pumped from the river. A bank of four 75 HP centrifugal pumps on the river delivered water to the ponds. After rediversion from the ponds, the water was conveyed to multiple farms through one 12" buried transite pipe and a 20" buried PVC pipe. At this specific place of use, the water was applied by a linear.


