GSI Water Solutions, Inc. (GSI) is submitting the enclosed application for a permanent water right transfer on behalf of Crowe Farms, LLC. The applicant is requesting to change the place of use for a 13.7-acre portion of Certificate 36432, and is also proposing to cancel a 6.4-acre portion of the authorized place of use concurrently with issuance of a final order approving this transfer application. The applicant requests a period of five years to complete the transfer.

Certificate 36432 authorizes the use of water from an unnamed stream and from Crowe Reservoir No. 2 for irrigation. The applicant is also filing an application for a permit to use the full authorized volume of water stored in Crowe Reservoirs No. 1 and 2 (combined total of 25.5 acre-feet). The use of stored water under this transfer in combination with the permit would not exceed 25.5 acre-feet.

Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application, and why: Certificate 36432 authorizes irrigation of 21.8 acres. The applicant is requesting to change the place of use for a 13.7 acre portion (0.17 cfs) of Certificate 36432 to irrigate a portion of a vineyard, and is proposing to cancel a 6.4-acre portion of the authorized place of use concurrently with issuance of a final order approving this transfer. Since the rate for Certificate 36432 is deficient (less than 1/80 cfs/acre), the authorized rate for this water right after cancellation of the 6.4 acres should continue to be 0.19 cfs (1/80 cfs/acre x 15.4 acres = 0.19 cfs). Certificate 36432 authorizes the use of direct flow from an unnamed stream and stored water from Crowe Reservoir No. 2. The applicant is also submitting an application for a permit to use the full authorized volume of water stored in Crowe Reservoirs No. 1 and 2 (combined total of 25.5 acre-feet). The use of stored water under this transfer in combination with the permit would not exceed a total of 25.5 acre-feet.

Additional remarks: This transfer application is requesting to change the place of use for a 13.7-acre portion of Certificate 36432 described in Table 2 and shown on the map in Attachment B. In addition, the applicant intends to cancel a 6.4-acre portion of this certificate concurrently with issuance of a final order approving this transfer, also shown on the map in Attachment B. The authorized rate for Certificate 36432 is deficient in that it authorizes 0.19 cfs to irrigate 21.8 acres (less than 1/80 cfs/acre). After the 6.4-acre portion of the right is cancelled, the authorized rate should remain 0.19 cfs for irrigation of 15.4 acres (equal to 1/80 cfs/acre). Therefore, the applicant is requesting to transfer a 0.17 cfs portion of the certificate to the proposed place of use (consistent with 1/80 cfs/acre for 13.7 acres).
Certificate 36432 authorizes the use of stored water from Crowe Reservoir No. 2 and direct flow from an unnamed stream. The applicant is concurrently filing an application for a permit to use the full authorized volume of stored water from Crowe Reservoirs No. 1 and 2 (25.5 acre-feet in total). The use of stored water under this transfer, in combination with the new permit, will not exceed a total of 25.5 acre-feet.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.19 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected within **Andrews DLC 58, Section 14, T. 6 S., R. 6 W., W.
