Water is diverted for certificate 48051 at the authorized POD - the head of the Gellerman Froman ditch (POD 4 in WRIS). The water flows northeast through the Gellerman Froman ditch approximately 12 miles where it is pumped from the Gellerman Froman ditch to the Warms Springs Pump Canal. The Warm Springs Pump Canal moves the water north, east, then south for approximately 9.2 miles where it enters the Irrigated property from the northeast. The existing water delivery system includes three siphon points along the Warm springs pump canal where the water flows onto the fields.

The proposed additional POD location was selected with the guidance of Mr. Randy Kinney, Manager of the Warm Springs Irrigation District. Mr. Kinney indicates that a headgate is located on the Warm Springs Pump Canal immediately upstream of where the Warm Springs Pump Canal flows under Willow Creek. This headgate allows Certificate 48051 water to flow from the pump canal into Willow Creek where it travels for approximately 0.8 miles to the Proposed APOD at the irrigated property. The Warm Springs Irrigation District manages control this headgate. This proposed APOD will allow the irrigators to more easily convey water to the western portion of their property. In this case, Willow Creek is acting as a ditch to convey water from The Warm Springs Pump Canal to the north central portion of the property. The irrigators are only withdrawing Warm Springs Pump Canal (Certificate 48051) water.

Water is diverted from Willow Creek for certificate 65891 at the authorized POD (530 ft N and 110 ft E from the west ¼ corner of Section 6). At the POD water is pumped from Willow Creek approximately 0.4 miles northwest to the Warms Springs Pump Canal. The Warm Springs Pump Canal moves the water north and east for approximately 3 miles where the water is returned to Willow Creek via a headgate located on the Warm Springs Pump Canal immediately upstream of where the Warm Springs Pump Canal flows under Willow Creek. The water flows south approximately 0.8 miles through Willow Creek and is applied to the fields via flood irrigation.
