- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs ÷100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
 - b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Add cfs for the portions of water rights on all the land included in the transfer; however do not count cfs for supplemental rights on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary right on the same land. The fee should be assessed only once for each "on the ground" acre included in the transfer. (In this example, blank 5a would be only 0.56 cfs, since both rights serve the same 45.0 acres. Sarah and Dwight,

Thanks for your patience as we reviewed the two transfers noted below. The difference in the outcome of the two technical reviews was due to a difference in the stream for which we evaluated "similarity", the Willamette River in T-13350 (large width, deeply incised, bed often scoured by high flows) vs a slough of the Willamette in T-13033 (narrow, shallowly incised, low energy fine-grained material in the bed). After review of the original certificate and claim materials, as well as historic topo maps, it appears that the original right is for a channel of the Willamette River (which has become a slough given channelization of the Willamette since the time of the original cert). As such, the Willamette R. in its current configuration is the appropriate water body for which we should assess similarity as per OAR 690-380-2130, and if an application similar to that for T-13033 was resubmitted we'd likely make a finding similar to that for T-13350.
