SUBJECT: Water Right Transfer Application T-13395

Please find enclosed the Preliminary Determination indicating that, based on the information available, the Department intends to approve application T-13395. This document is an intermediate step in the approval process; water may not be used legally as proposed in the transfer application until a Final Order has been issued by the Department. Please read this entire letter carefully to determine your responsibility for additional action.

A public notice is being published in the Department's weekly publication and in the Burns Times Herald newspaper, simultaneously with issuance of the Preliminary Determination. The notice initiates a period in which any person may file either a protest opposing the decision proposed by the Department in the Preliminary Determination or a standing statement supporting the Department's decision. The protest period will end 30 days after the last date of newspaper publication.

If no protest is filed, the Department will issue a Final Order consistent with the Preliminary Determination. You should receive a copy of the Final Order about 30 days after the close of the protest period.

If a protest is filed, the application may be referred to a contested case proceeding. A contested case provides an opportunity for the proponents and opponents of the decision proposed in the Preliminary Determination to present information and arguments supporting their position in a quasi-judicial proceeding.

IMPORTANT: Due to COVID-19, the Department's office is closed to walk-in services. The Department encourages the submission of protests by U.S. mail. Please consider mailing early to ensure the Department receives the protest by the deadline specified above.

Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Applicant

Findings of Fact

- On March 18, 2020, WILLIAM DUNBAR, DUNBAR SILVIES RIVER RANCH filed an application for additional points of diversion and a change in places of use under Certificates 1991, 11060, and 33152, and additional points of appropriation and a change in places of use under Certificates 28656 and 33151. The Department assigned the application number T-13395.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on March 24, 2020, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On August 6, 2021, the Department contacted the applicant by written correspondence to notify the applicant and the applicant's agent of deficiencies in the application. A change in place of use under five water right certificates is involved in T-13395, and only one map was submitted. Pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rule 690-380-3100(1)(i), if the proposed transfer involves changes in place of use or character of use for more than three water rights, a separate map shall be provided for each water right. The "FROM" and "TO" lands

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, any person may file a protest or standing statement within 30 days after the last date of publication of notice of this preliminary determination.

for each certificate did not match between each Table 2 and the map. The Department requested that the deficiencies be resolved by September 7, 2021.

- 4. On August 7, 2021, the applicant's agent submitted revised tables and maps, resolving the deficiencies.
- 5. On September 8, 2021, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13395 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of October 8, 2021, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

23. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.

- 24. A diversion structure and ditch sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-13395.
- 25. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 26. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 27. All other application requirements are met.

Determination and Proposed Action

The additional points of diversion, additional points of appropriation, and change in places of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13395 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the application will be approved.

If Transfer Application T-13395 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- The additional points of diversion, additional points of appropriation, and change in places
 of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13395 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 1991, 1991, 11060, 28656, 33151, and 33152, and any related decree.
- 3. Water right Certificates 1991, 1991, 11060, 28656, 33151, and 33152 are cancelled. A new certificate will be issued describing that portion of Certificate 28656 not affected by this transfer.
- 4. The quantity of water, as authorized by Certificate 1991, diverted at the new additional point of diversion (POD 4), together with that diverted at the original point of diversion (POD 1), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD 1).
- 5. The quantity of water, as authorized by Certificate 11060, diverted at the new additional point of diversion (POD 4), together with that diverted at the original point of diversion (POD 3), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD 3).
- 6. The quantity of water, as authorized by Certificate 28656, diverted at the new additional points of appropriation (Well #2 and Well #3), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (Wayne Howes Well #2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (Wayne Howes Well #2).

- 7. The quantity of water, as authorized by Certificate 33151, diverted at the new additional points of appropriation (Well #3 and Howes Well #2), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (Jacobs Well No. 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (Jacobs Well No. 2).
- 8. The quantity of water, as authorized by Certificate 33152, diverted at the new additional point of diversion (POD 4), together with that diverted at the original point of diversion (POD 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD 2).
- Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion/appropriation (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
- 11. The former places of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water under the rights.
- 12. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2023**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
