Certificate 42342 authorizes 14.2 acres of irrigation. The well authorized for the irrigation of the 14.2 acres is located on our neighbors 7.1 acres. Sharing the use of this well the last few years has become awkward. We propose to drill a new well on our land so we have a source for irrigation at times when our neighbor's well is unavailable to us.

I attach a 2-inch rubber hose to the risers and irrigated my pasture with a portable 45 gpm big gun sprinkler.


