 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs ÷100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
 - b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Shotgun POD 1, also identified as POD 6, serves this POU and other water rights. Water is gravity flowed in a pipeline from a reservoir in the SWSW of Section 9 to a 25-hp centrifugal pump located in the NWNW of Section 10. The pumped water is then piped to a bulge located in the NESW of Section 8. Water gravity flowed from the bulge is applied using wheel lines. The computed pump capacity is 1.44 cfs, but the gravity flow pipe from the bulge to the POU has a computed capacity of 0.75 cfs.

There are 20 40-feet-long lengths of wheel lines with 9/64th inch nozzles. A table in the Department's CBU forms indicates the nozzles produce 4 gpm at 50 psi. The 20 nozzles have a theoretical capacity of 80 gpm (0.18 cfs). In addition to the wheel lines, a Kifco T-180 water reel has been used for irrigation. The water reel has a 3/8-inch nozzle that delivers 26 gpm (0.06 cfs) at 35 psi.

<u>Drake Creek 1 (Ream Ditch) and Drake Creek 2 do not deliver water to the acres involved in the transfer.</u>

POD 3 has a 40-hp centrifugal pump. The lift from the source to pump is approximately 2 feet and the lift to a connection in the SW SE of Section 4 is estimated to be 70 feet. Assuming the pump operates with an open discharge, the theoretical pump capacity is 3.78 cfs (approximately 1695 gpm) based on the Department's online calculators.

The supplemental irrigation of the 10 acres proposed for transfer can be irrigated using a 4,000gallon water truck and a trailer with an approximately 6,000-gallon tank, for a combined total of 10,000 gallons. The water can be delivered to a bulge at POD 6 in the SW SW of Section 9. The same system described for POD 6 (aka Shotgun Creek POD 1) in Certificate 94456 can be used to irrigate the 10.0 acres proposed for transfer.


