Therefore, we are requesting permission to use only as much ground water as necessary for the crops already planted. With surface water being our only permitted alternative for an irrigation water supply, when the surface water supply is reduced or not provided we cannot produce crops to pay our bills, feed our family, pay our mortgages on property and equipment, taxes, and also will not be able to satisfy product delivery required in previously executed food supply agreement. There are no surface reservoirs to obtain water from. The decision to deliver all, a portion, or no water to us is made by the Federal and State Agencies, and is out of our control.




