

On August 2, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by William A. Vaughn for approval of a change in place of use of water from Cow Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The order of the Water Resources Director entered April 29, 1980, at page 167, Volume 33, Special Order Record, approving Transfer 4268, was in error in allowing 0.115 cubic foot per second from Cow Creek.

The amount of water that should be allowed is 3.8 Miners Inches (0.096 cfs).

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that line 3, paragraph 2, page 167 of said Volume 33 be amended to allow 3.8 Miners Inches of water from Cow Creek.





On August 2, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by William A. Vaughn for approval of a change in place of use of water from Cow Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 14554, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Opal Jarvis, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.115 cubic foot per second from Cow Creek for irrigation of a certain 4.6 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 19, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1901.





SUBJECT: Cow Creek Irrigating Company and William Vaughn

On April 3rd, I met with Chet Smith, Secretary of the Company, to show him the materials you had forwarded. He indicated the major changes to the channel occurred during the 1974 flood on Cow Creek. (It was more severe than the 1964-1965 flood). He further said that when they installed the ditch the next year, it was necessary to "extend" the ditch through fresh alluvial material (sand and gravel) to get water into the ditch and that they closely followed the old channel of Cow Creek. to be born out in the maps). Also, at the time, it certainly did not appear to them that this would be a "permanent extension" of the ditch. I asked Chet whether or not he thought the flood protection from Galesville Reservoir would make it permanent, and he thought not. Indeed, Galesville would have spilled during the 1974 event and there is substantial additional inflow downstream from the dam. I did not pursue the matter further, in view of the proposed administrative rule.

In way of comment on the proposed rule, I would question the limitation to a 1/4-1/4 section. If a person's diversion happened to be within 10 feet of a 1/4-1/4 line, a meander could force him to file for a transfer if it was necessary for him to move as little as 20 feet to compensate. I would rather see it limited to a distance from his original POD (e.g., 1/4 mile either way).

On the same day, I met with Mr. Vaughn regarding his dissatisfaction with the final proof survey. He did not have any problems with the transfer map, but thought the Cow Creek Irrigation Company ditch should be mentioned in the proof. He really did not have a problem with the reservoir proof. He does not, however, as stated in his letter, divert live flow into the reservoir. According to him, the reservoir area was a slough at one time and fill was brought in to drain the land. I,

therefore, have no doubt but what the "reservoir" is hydraulically connected to the creek and is, therefore, filled from Cow Creek. On this basis, he signed the reservoir proof and I am forwarding it, along with the other proofs (which need correction).

He does have, as you suspected, a problem with the land between the ditch and creek not being surveyed. He also thinks that most of the areas cut out along his north and west lines should have been included. He also would like the pipeline to be shown if possible. I would, therefore, recommend that Mike and Jim survey these particular features at their earliest convenience.

SUBJECT:

I was of the opinion the change made by Cow Creek Irrigating Company was a one-time occurrence and not an annual occurrence as indicated by your memo. It appeared from the Vaughn final proof survey and map that the ditch had actually been extended 530+ feet upstream to intersect the channel of Cow Creek at a new location. Surveys of 1941 and 1963 show the diversion in the same original location. Surveys of 1979 and 1984 show the diversion at its present location. I suspect the major change occurred with the high water of 1964-1965. The placement of their diversion dam in the stream is not an issue.

The location of the original diversion point was determined by examination of the 1941 survey made to determine the vested rights of Cow Creek. The survey is a part of the record and a part of the rights. A 1963 final proof survey regarding a change in point of diversion for Chester Smith under S-127 also fixes the point of diversion to a specific location for the ditch.

The need for filing an application for change in point of diversion on a meandering stream has been discussed extensively, and we are considering the adoption of an administrative rule to resolve the issue. A <u>draft</u> of the rule follows. Please note the application is <u>not required</u>, but may be accepted in the event of a one-time change.

DRAFT

690-015-015 An application for change in point of diversion is not required for a diversion point to follow the movements of a naturally changing stream channel if the diversion point stays within the same quarter-quarter section and the change does not move the diversion point upstream or downstream beyond the diversion point of another appropriator.

The Company can submit the application for change in point of diversion listing the various lands and rights involved. I was not aware of this when I wrote Mr. Smith and suggested each user make application for change. This may have some bearing on future decisions regarding this.

Regarding Mr. Vaughn, he submitted an application requesting a permit to store water from Cow Creek by diversion into Cow Creek Irrigating Company ditch then pumping from the ditch into his reservoir. He said he would pump from the reservoir onto his land using the same pump. We approved his request and issued permit R-6435.

Memo to Gary Ball March 10, 1986 Page Two

On October 15, 1979, J. S. Donaldson contacted Mr. Vaughn and made the final proof survey and customary report. Apparently, Mr. Vaughn does not remember the visit some six years ago. Donaldson reported a system much the same as Vaughn requested in his application.

Vaughn doesn't say what his complaint with the map is but I suspect some confusion between land under transfer 4268 and permit 40371. I also note from the application he intended to irrigate 2.0 acres between the ditch and county road. Donaldson did not report or map land in this location

as irrigated or not.

- 1) Another couple points of possible confusion: when transfer application 4268 was examined it was found to conflict with permit 40371 insofar as Cow Creek was concerned. We requested an affidavit of abandonment on the 4.6 acres under transfer which may have been an error since stored water could still be used as supplemental. Since considerably less than 30 acres was found, I choose to restore the option to use stored water on the south 4.6 acres. Donaldson's report would indicate this to be the case.
- 2) Donaldson reports a portable pipeline system. Now Vaughn seems to think we should show the location of a buried pipeline on the map. Please help us locate it.

Following copies enclosed: Applications R-53760, 53761, 1941 Survey of point of diversion, Donaldson's reports and map, proof for R-6435, 40371, and 4268, Vaughn's letter, Order S-127.

We can do the following:

- 1. Cancel permit R-6435 if Cow Creek water not stored.
- 2. Delete south 4.6 acres from proof under permit 40371.
- 3. Prepare a new proof and map for Cow Creek only.
- 4. The new map to be prepared based upon your inspection and contact with Mr. Vaughn (what does he want?).
- 5. Add land to the proof if all elements of proof are present. (B date 10/1/78, C date 10/1/79).
- 6. Mr. Vaughn could sign the proofs as is.

Your report and recommendation would be appreciated.

Dear Mr. Smith:

It has recently come to our attention that Cow Creek has changed channel location by moving southerly in the vicinity of the diversion for Cow Creek Irrigating Company. Since this shift in channel occurred, the irrigating company has relocated their point of diversion from Cow Creek by moving approximately 500 feet upstream.

The water right records for the various users of the water from the ditch describe the point of diversion at its original location.

The water right records should be updated for the various users who obtain their water from the ditch to describe the new location of the point of diversion.

You might inform the users of the ditch at a company meeting or by a mailing from the company.

I am enclosing an application for change of an existing water right. An application must be submitted for each separate perfected water right receiving water from the ditch. Since numerous applications may be needed, additional forms can be obtained from the Watermaster's Office in Roseburg, or you may request the number needed and we will gladly mail them to you. If additional information regarding this change is needed, the Watermaster can also be of assistance. The Watermaster for your vicinity is Gary Ball, Room 104, Justice Building in Roseburg.




