*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Permit S-12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Permit S-87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each permit involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the permit (for S-12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be changed to get the application cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
 - b. If the water right permit does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For S-87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Add cfs for the portions of permits on all the land included in the application; however **do not count** cfs for supplemental permits on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary permit on the same land. The fee should be assessed only once for each "on the ground" acre included in the application. (In this example, blank 5a would be only 0.56 cfs, since both permits serve the same 45.0 acres. Good Afternoon Natalie,

The Department grants a map scale waiver for the application maps. Please include a copy of this email when you file the applications.

As to your evidence of use question, evidence of use is not required for GR Modifications. The Department is not authorized to make a determination of use of a Groundwater Registration. The adjudication court will do that whenever the Groundwater Registrations are adjudicated. Secondly, it appears that you will need to file a permit amendment application instead of a transfer application for Permit G-18326. The permit has not been certificated yet and indeed appears to have been extended to 2096. Evidence of use is not required for a permit amendment.

Hello Kelly,

Here are the two maps I'd like to have the scale okayed. They are for the same area, but one is a water right transfer and the other is a groundwater claim modification. Please let me know if this is ok. The scale on both is 1"=500ft.

I also have another question on the transfer application that I'm not sure who to ask. On the evidence of use form none of the supporting documents seem to be the right category for what happened. Here is what happened. The people who originally filled out the paperwork for the water right when they constructed the subdivision/water district filled it out improperly and included ¼ ¼s that weren't in the water district and missing some that were in the water district. The water district has always served the full area of the water district because they assumed the water right was filled out correctly because it was done specifically for the subdivision construction. It wasn't until an extension became necessary that they really read the details of it and realized that they needed to transfer the water right to the areas they are
