Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application and why: On March 21, 2022 Gov. Kate Brown declared a drought in Jefferson County (Executive Order #22-04), and in Deschutes County (Executive Order #22-07) on April 25, 2022. Debra Jane Davis owns lands in Deschutes County with Central Oregon Irrigation District (COID) certificate #94956/76714 water rights. Debra Jane Davis desires to transfer 3.92 acres of COID irrigation water off her property and to a property owned by Madras Farms Co. Madras Farms Co. owns lands with appurtenant North Unit Irrigation District (NUID) certificate #72279 irrigation water rights, both sourced from the Deschutes River. NUID rights are the most junior on the Upper Deschutes River and is further limited by reduced live flow due to the drought. This temporary drought transfer will provide Madras Farms Co. with senior water rights for the 2022 season. The transfer proposes to temporarily remove water from COID patron lands, transport the water to the end of the COID Pilot Butte Canal (PBC), and spill it into the NUID canal and delivered to NUID lands were identified on the application maps. A change in POD is not required to accomplish this transfer.

Additional remarks: The POD will not change. If this transfer is approved, the transferred water will continue to be diverted from the Deschutes River at POD #11 by COID and will be transported through the PBC to the end of their system where it will spill into the NUID canal. There is a

- gauge located at the spill that is read by COID daily. Readings are reported to OWRD monthly. The proposed water will be carried by the NUID
- ranal to the proposed lands. The COID water right can only be used on the proposed lands as identified on the submitted transfer map. Delivery and measurement will be conducted by NUID staff and will not exceed the maximum rate and duty allowed by the underlying NUID water rights
- and measurement will be conducted by NUID staff and will not exceed the maximum rate and duty allowed by the underlying NUID water rights (certificate 72279 together with all other rights perfected under permit 23196, and certificate 72281 together with all other rights perfected
- under permit 25921). The water proposed for transfer will be passed over the NUID spill for the remainder of the 2022 irrigation season, or until such time as NUID canal is regulated off at the Deschutes River.
