*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Certificate 12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Certificate 87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
 - b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Add cfs for the portions of water rights on all the land included in the transfer; however do not count cfs for supplemental rights on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary right on the same land. The fee should be assessed only once for each "on the ground" acre included in the transfer. (In this example, blank 5a would be only 0.56 cfs, since both rights serve the same 45.0 acres. Blank 5b would be 0 and Line 5 would then also become 0).

Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Water is currently pumped from Well #4 into a small regulating reservoir where it is mixed with Rhea Creek water if water from Rhea Creek is available under Water Right Certificate 76875. Well #4 is equipped with a 200 hp deep well turbine pump. Both ground water and Rhea Creek Water is pumped from the regulating reservoir with a pond booster pumping station consisting of two short coupled canned turbine pumps (one 150 hp and one 200 hp) through a mainline and distribution system that serves 2 center pivots that are used to irrigate the land authorized by Certificate 48296. There is a field booster pumping station on the farm that is used to boost the system pressure if necessary. A total of 191.9 acres are irrigated under this water right. Refer to the transfer application map for the layout of the irrigation system and circles.
