- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
 - b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application, and why:

I am proposing to move our permanent water right diversion point downstream to install a new water system on our own private property for domestic use.

We currently share a water right certificate and water system with a neighboring home across the street. We are selling our home and the landowner saw and has stated he will deny water and the right to his property for maintenance to the new owners of our home. After eight weeks, he is unwilling to come to an agreement with us to reslove the dispute. We have been advised by an Oregon water rights attorney that while we have a solid case against him, moving our diversion point to our property and installing our own system will be less expensive and less stressful than lifigation since we can't be promised or guarnteed to be awarded our attorney fees or cost of damages he has caused.

This stream is our only option to supply water to our home.

Current Surface Water Spring System

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Water collection intake is located at the authorized POD in T3S, R9W, Section 29. Water is diverted from the stream through a pipe at the authorized POD and flows through the pipe to a large cement collection holding tank. The holding tank is located near the half-way point between the POD and where the waterline splits at a "Y" to each registered household. From the holding tank, the water flows down through approximately 2,300 feet of pipe to the Finnell household (Lundberg HO) located in T3S, R9W, Section 28.





Proposed Surface Water System

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Water collection intake would be located at proposed POD in T3S, R9W, Section 28, NW of SW. Intake pipe at the proposed POD will have an attached foot valve with screen. A check valve with a backflow preventer will be installed to prevent water backflow into the stream and ensure consistent pump priming. Water will be diverted at the proposed POD using a ¾ hp well jet pump. Diverted water will travel through approximately 75' of 1-1/4 water line to a 500 gallon above ground storage tank. The above ground storage tank will have an automatic float system installed to regulate automatic water drafting/pumping from proposed POD. From the storage tank, water will flow to a pressure tank. The pressure tank will push water through a series of filters to the existing home water pipes.

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
^{*}If required by ODFW, a certified fish screen will be installed on the foot valve at the proposed POD.

^{*}A small artificial removable water collection box may be installed at the proposed POD if ODFW and OWRD will allow it. This would not eliminate the ODFW certified fish screen if required.

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
