



confirms the right to use the waters of LUCKIAMUTE RIVER, tributary to WILLAMETTE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 68.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 31076. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 22, 1965. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.86 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the authorized point of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.
