Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application, and why:

The City of Umatilla is the permit holder of Permit S-41444 for 23.0 cfs on the Columbia River (the "Permit"). As issued, the Permit possesses a single approved point of diversion which is mapped at a point approximately 50-ft off shore of the Columbia River and, therefore, creates an inaccessible location for a diversion structure (depicted as "POD-1"). Due to the location of the original POD, the City has been unable to construct the originally-approved diversion structure and, therefore, has been unable to divert water under the Permit as authorized. Furthermore, the City's planned development of the Permit will also require additional points of diversion in order to divert and distribute the water as needed throughout the City's service area.

This amendment application seeks to accomplish the following:

- 1. Remove any reference in the Permit to the originally permitted **POD-1**;
- 2. Add to the Permit the POD depicted as "POD-2", which is an existing diversion structure owned and used by the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation (CTUIR), and which, by written agreement with the CTUIR, will continue to be used by CTUIR and temporarily used by the City of Umatilla until the completion of a new POD depicted as "POD-3";
- 3. Add to the Permit a new POD depicted as "POD-3", which will be a new diversion structure which, once completed, will fully replace the operation of the CTUIR's existing POD depicted as POD-2;
- 4. Add to the Permit the previously described new **POD-3**, which will be used to divert and apply to beneficial use water diverted under both the Permit and, by written agreement with the CTUIR, the CTUIR's existing water rights;
- 5. Add to the Permit a POD depicted as "**POD-4**", which is an existing diversion structure owned and operated by the City of Umatilla and which is currently used for the diversion of City of Umatilla water rights; and
- 6. Add to the Permit a POD depicted as "**POD-5**", which is an existing diversion structure co-owned and operated by the City of Hermiston and the Port of Umatilla.

**Applicant Comment:** The proposed amendment to incorporate four new PODs to Permit S-41444 includes two (POD-2 and POD-3) which are located on US Army Corps of Engineers land and within an easement held by the CTUIR, the purpose of which is to allow for the location of surface water diversion and conveyance structures. The City of Umatilla has an agreement with CTUIR to both utilize the CTUIR's existing diversion structure (POD 2) and construct a new diversion structure (POD 3) on these lands such that both entities can utilize the diversion structures for appropriation of their respective water rights.

- 2) The application is for a water right transfer, allocation of conserved water, exchange, permit amendment, or ground water registration modification, and <u>all</u> of the following apply:
  - a) The existing and proposed water use is located entirely within lands zoned for exclusive farm-use or within an irrigation district;
  - b) The application involves a change in place of use only;
  - c) The change does not involve the placement or modification of structures, including but not limited to water diversion, impoundment, distribution facilities, water wells and well houses; and
  - d) The application involves irrigation water uses only.

the Permit by securing new PODs in order that it may apply to beneficial use and ultimately perfect its water right interest authorized under the Permit.

The City's application to amend its Permit seeks to accomplish the following:

- 1. Remove any reference in the Permit to the originally permitted POD;
- 2. Add to the Permit an existing POD owned and operated by the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation (CTUIR), which diverts the CTUIR's existing water rights from the Columbia River and the pumphouse for which POD is located on property owned by the USACE ("CTUIR Existing POD").
- 3. Add to the Permit a new POD, which will be a new diversion structure that, once completed, will fully replace

the operation of the CTUIR Existing POD and which new POD will be operated in conjunction with a new pumphouse (to be located approximately 100' to the west of the existing pumphouse) on the same property owned by the USACE and that, once completed, will fully replace the CTUIR's existing pumphouse and will be used to divert and apply to beneficial use water diverted under both the Permit and the CTUIR's existing water rights (the "New CTUIR POD");

- **4.** Add to the Permit a POD currently located and operating in the McNary Pool, which is (a) an existing diversion structure owned and owned and operated by the City of Umatilla, and (b) is currently used for the diversion of other City of Umatilla water rights; and
- **5.** Add to the Permit a POD currently located and operating in the McNary Pool, which (a) is an existing diversion structure co-owned by the City of Hermiston and the Port of Umatilla, (b) is operated and maintained by the City of Hermiston pursuant to an agreement between the City of Hermiston and the Port of Umatilla, and (c) will be used by the City of Umatilla to appropriate water under the Permit and convey such water to and through the RWS pipeline for delivery to the City of Hermiston.
