The water user seeks 3 changes in this transfer: a POD change from JA Vaughn Ditch to the North Intake, an APOD change to add the Park Intake, and a POU change to reflect the actual irrigated areas.

The water user is aware that this transfer will result in partial diminution of Cert 72609 since only 21.44 acres of 63.00 permitted acres are being used for irrigation. A signed affidavit for the Voluntary Partial Diminution of a Water Right Certificate is attached to this application.

The water user seeks these changes to certificate 72609 to reflect the fact the original POD (JA Vaughn Ditch) located on Pine Creek was abandoned sometime in the 1970's and two different PODs (North Intake) has been in use for at least the past 40 years.

The original authorized point of diversion (JA Vaughn Ditch) has not been in use for at least 50 years. Pine Creek Water is currently diverted from two intakes on the Snake River. The North Intake is located approximately 1,700 ft downstream of the confluence with Pine Creek and the Park Intake is located approximately 550 ft downstream of the confluence with Pine Creek. The North Intake water is distributed to the places of use north and west of road NF-454 via buried mainline and the Water from the Park Intake is distributed to the places of use south and east of road NF-454 via buried mainline. Water is applied to the irrigated areas via sprinklers.


