

Measurement, recording, and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the right. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The use of water under this right is subject to the terms and conditions of Water Service Contract No. 5-07-10-W1082 or a satisfactory replacement between the Bureau of Reclamation and the water user, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

Notwithstanding the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife has made a determination that by-pass devices are not necessary at this time, the water user may be required in the future to install, maintain, and operate by-pass devices to prevent fish from entering the diversion, and to provide adequate upstream and downstream passage for fish.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve the end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledge land-use plan.
