#### **Description of Water Delivery System**

System capacity: <u>.96</u> cubic feet per second (cfs)

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Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. A headgate exists on Birdseye Creek to divert water into a gravity fed buried pipeline and ditch to the authorized place of use. Water is used from the ditch on the portion of the place of use included in this application by pumping water into storage tanks used as a bulge in the system and then piping the water through a buried mainline to drip tape used to irrigate plants. A big gun sprinkler is also used to irrigate forage for goats.


