

Re: Measurement and Reporting for Split Season Lease

For water rights 94781 and 95217 the duty is 1.0 acre-feet per acre every 30 day period May 1-July 31, and 1 acre-foot per acre for all of August 1- September 31. Because the instream period for the proposed split season lease begins on August 1 and ends on September 30, and because the irrigation duty limitation for August 1 - September 31 is independent of irrigation duty usage from May 1- July 31, the water master is not requiring measuring devices to monitor duty usage from May 1- July 31 for these water rights. Compliance with the terms of the split season lease and confirmation that no irrigation water is being applied to acres involved in the proposed split season lease from August 1-September 31 will be confirmed by regular site visits by the water master and Trout Unlimited staff.
