Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application, and why:

Certificate 93746 is for industrial/manufacturing uses and has only one point of appropriation (POA) on the right, Well-1 (WASH-002/WASH-199). The Applicant recently discovered damage to the casing of Well-1 that prevents the pump/motor assembly from being reinstalled and operating in its standard configuration. The damage to the casing is not immediately repairable and the well is proposed for abandonment. This transfer application is being submitted to move the approved POA on Certificate 93746 to the location of a replacement well. The proposed new well will be constructed in a similar manner to Well-1 in order to match the hydraulic properties and source aquifer of the original POA on the water right.

The current POA, Well-1, is located at the west end of the Oregon-Canadian Forest Products property. The well pumps directly into a 6" mainline of the industrial water distribution system. The mainline branches into 1-4" lateral lines which carry the water throughout the property and the place of use. Water is used in the boilers, kilns, steam generators, and other lumber related processes in the place of use.

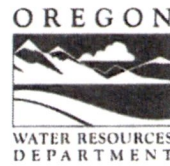



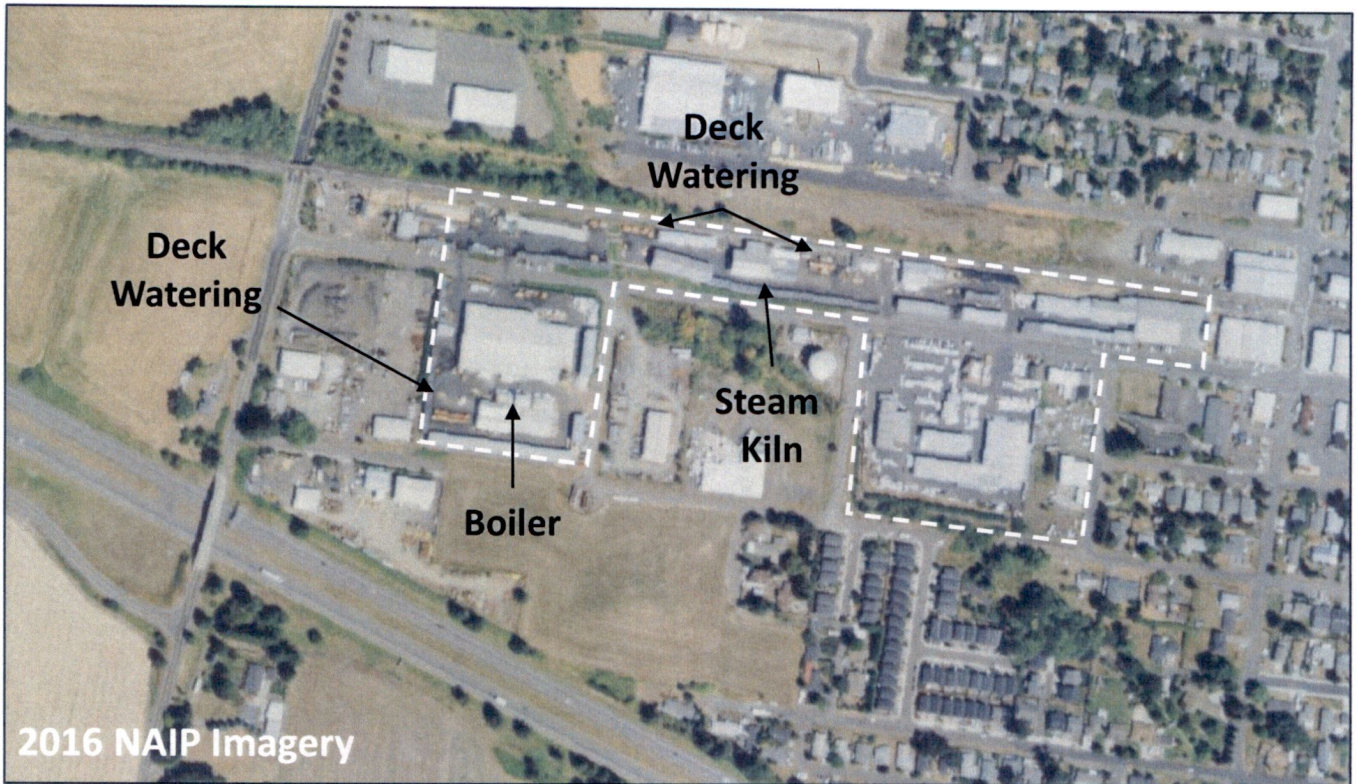

Hi Bob,

Apologies for the delay in getting back to you. In looking at the WASH 199 deepening log, the driller reported two "broken basalt" WBZs separated by "basalt with holes", with both "broken basalt" WBZs reported to have the same rate of production and static head. Assuming the same is true with a step-over replacement well, it appears that the well would meet minimum construction standards. If you do decide to install a replacement well, a transfer app would be needed to authorize the new well as a POD on the existing Certificate.

If you have further inquiries related to sites in the north Willamette Valley (roughly north of Willsonville) please direct them to Dennis (copied here), who's the hydrogeologist looking after that region of the state and who will be able to provide you with more timely service.

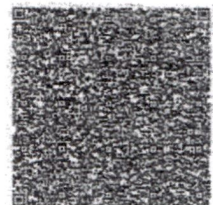
