- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs ÷100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
 - b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

The City of Aurora is the holder of water right Certificate 87380, which authorizes the appropriation of 0.56 cubic feet per section (cfs) of groundwater for municipal use, and Certificate 87381, which authorizes the use of 0.5 cfs of groundwater for municipal use. The City is filing the enclosed transfer application to add three wells (Well 3R, Well 6A, and Well 6B) to the Certificates. Please note that the City intends to complete construction of either Well 6A or Well 6B, but not both. The City's application includes two proposed additional points of appropriation in order to reflect the possibility that the well will be completed on either tax lot 100 or 1400 (both of which are owned by the City) as reflected in the Land Use Information Form signed by Marion County. As noted in the Land Use Information Form provided by Marion County, the City has not yet submitted an application to Marion County planning for approval of the wells on the identified tax lots. The City plans to submit the necessary applications to Marion County in the future and will provide an updated Land Use Information Form reflecting that the City is pursuing approval or has received required approvals prior to the issuance of a Preliminary Determination.

Also enclosed is a check for the required processing fee of \$3,270.
