CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GALE CORWIN KAREN CORWIN PO BOX 184 PRAIRIE CITY OR 97869

confirms the right to use the waters of INDIAN CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 7.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1881.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled, for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to September 30, measured at the point of diversion.

Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


