



Any additional information about the right: The 15.9 acres proposed in this instream lease are divided into two sections. A 3.9-acre section is located north of the railroad tracks and covers an agricultural field where the Applicant will not need irrigation for the grass seed crop in the near future. The remaining 12.0 acres are located along an old landing strip and associated gravel paths, which has been watered to maintain a living grass cover and to reduce dust, and additional acres now under grass seed production. The Applicant will no longer apply water to these areas under this lease. Irrigation on the total 15.9 acres under Certificate 26161 will be stopped during the lease period.
