

- 22. Certificate 90397 does not specify the irrigation season. However, the Crooked River

 Decree establishes the irrigation season for the area as February 1 to December 1.
- 23. There are supplemental irrigation water rights, Certificate 33012, 83850, 87548, and 90382, appurtenant to all or a portion of the lands described in Finding of Facts No. 2 through 21. The Lessors have requested that these portions of water rights not be included as part of this lease application. During the term of the lease, water use under this right will also be suspended.
- 24. The lease application includes the information required under OAR 690-077-0076(3). The Department provided notice of the lease application pursuant to OAR 690-077-0077(1). No comments were received.
- 25. The instream use has been modified from the lease application to prevent injury and enlargement and is as follows:

- 27. The amount and timing of the proposed instream flow is allowable within the limits and use of the original water rights.
- 28. The protection of flows within the proposed reach is appropriate, considering:
 - a. The instream water use begins at the recorded point of diversion;
 - b. The location of confluences with other streams downstream of the point of diversion.
 - c. There are no known areas of natural loss of streamflow to the river bed downstream from the point of diversion; and
 - d. Any return flows resulting from the exercise of the existing water right would re-enter the river downstream of the reach of the instream water right.
- 29. The total monthly quantities of water to be protected under the existing and proposed instream rights in the reach will provide for a beneficial purpose.
- 30. The total monthly quantities of water to be protected instream under existing and proposed instream rights in the reach do not exceed the estimated average natural flow.
- 31. If approved, this instream lease is not reasonably expected to significantly affect land use as prescribed by ORS 197.180, OAR Chapter 660, Divisions 30 and 31, and OAR Chapter 690, Division 5.
- 32. Based upon review of the application, information provided by the Department's Watermaster, and other available information, the Department finds that the lease will not result in injury or enlargement. The order approving this instream lease may be modified or revoked under OAR 690-077-0077 if the Department later finds that the lease is causing RECEIVED injury to any existing water right or enlargement of the original right.

- 33. If a right which has been leased is later proposed to be leased again, transferred and/or reviewed under an allocation of conserved water, a new injury review shall be required. - 3. The term of the lease will commence upon approval of the instream lease and terminate on December 1, 2021. For multiyear leases, the lessors shall have the option of terminating the lease any time each year with written notice to the Department. However, if the termination request is received less than 30-days prior to the instream use period (February 1 through December 1) or after the water rights' original period of allowed use has begun, the Department may issue an order terminating the lease but use of water may not be allowed until the following calendar year, unless the Director determines that enlargement would not occur.
