- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
 - b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application, and why: We are adding a Point of Diversion and revising the Place of Beneficial Use. This would allow us to irrigate a 6 Acre portion of an Open Field lying South of Elk River. This would involve the use of a Portable Pump System, (resembling the ones currently in use) to be located on the southerly bank of the river. It will be taken or withdrawing (3 Acers) from the 22.2 Acre Irrigated Section located in the NW ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 27, T. 32 S. – R.15 W.,WM. Thus reducing that area to 19.2 Acres. And, taking or withdrawing (3 Acres) from the 13.4 Acre Irrigated Section located in the NE ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 27, T. 32 S. – R. 15 W.,W.M. Thus reducing that area to 10.4 Acres.

The existing system consists of Portable Irrigation Sprinkler Lines that are moved across the fields. Currently the fields are leased to separate parties. The Pumps are mounted on small wheeled trailers and are located on the Bank of the River directly adjacent and or above the Points of Diversion. The Pump Units run daily during the irrigation season for 2 to 3 hour periods .Most of the distribution lines are 3" to 4" Aluminum Pipe. The Intakes consist of 4" Flexpipe or Hoses. Each Intake is screened and removed from the River after the Sprinkler Period. The Pumps are 15 Horsepower and appear to be standard Briggs and Stratton Motors. The pumps are inline suction units with no manufacturer information available. At this time the Distribution Systems are broken down and transported to another field depending upon needs.


