Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application, and why: The Applicant is proposing to change the place of use and character of use for two water rights in their entirety (Certificates 53194 and 53196) and portions of three water rights (Certificates 53193, 53195, and 53260). The Applicant is also proposing to change the Point of Appropriation for the two groundwater rights (Certificates 53193 & 53194). The water rights (or portions of rights) being transferred authorize the use of water for irrigation and supplemental irrigation, and are appurtenant to a total of 101.5 acres. The Applicant intends to use water under the water rights for industrial use when its primary source of industrial water supply is not available. The Applicant understands that use of water under the transferred water rights will be limited to a combined maximum authorized rate of 2.54 cfs and an annual volume of 456.75 AF based on per acre limitations of 1/40th cfs and 4.5 AF per acre. The Applicant is requesting 10 years to complete the changes proposed in this transfer application.
