Dear Patron,

Owyhee Irrigation District or OID reviews water deliveries and maps to track beneficial use of the water rights we deliver. This practice helps OID protect and preserve the water rights that are delivered under our contract with United States Bureau of Reclamation. (1951 Amendatory Contract)

During the 2022 water year review process our records indicate that a <u>portion</u> or <u>all</u> of the water right available to the above-noted property has NOT been beneficially used for 4 consecutive years. Oregon Revised Statute 540.610 clearly states the requirements of beneficial use.

This letter is a request for you to confirm that the information contained herein is correct or provide evidence of any deficiencies.

540.610 Use as measure of water right; presumption of forfeiture of right for nonuse; basis for rebutting presumption; confirmation of rights of municipalities. (1) Beneficial use shall be the basis, the measure, and the limit of all rights to the use of water in this state. Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right ceases or fails to use all or part of the water appropriated for a period of five successive years, the failure to use shall establish a rebuttable presumption of forfeiture of all or part of the water right.

Failure to prove beneficial use as stated is a very serious matter and is cause for forfeiture of the unused water right. At this time, you have <u>3 options</u> to protect this water right, they are as follows:

- 1. You must use the full water right on the ground exactly as it is mapped during the 2023 irrigation season (see enclosed aerial photo for location of mapped water rights)
 - a. Contact the office by phone, email or in person to notify the district of your decision to use the water rights.

- 2. Relinquish your water rights.
 - a. If you choose this option, sign, date, & return the attached Relinquish Form to the District Office.
- 3. Lease, at minimum, the unused portion of the water right back into the stream for the 2023 season (the District will accept requests for temporary lease applications through February 15, 2023). The water will go back onto your property at the end of the irrigation season (see enclosed information sheet)

If you choose not to follow any of these options, the District will have no choice but to confiscate the unused water right at the end of the 2023 season by filing a petition with Oregon Water Resources Department to transfer the water rights to other lands in the District.

As a courtesy, the District is informing you that if this property has any other water rights specifically appurtenant to it that are delivered from another source (non-OID water), that water (per ORS 540.510) may be subject to cancellation by Oregon Water Resources Department should OID be forced to file a confiscation transfer.

By this letter, be advised non-use during the 2023 water season will lead to a determination that the land is no longer irrigated or susceptible to irrigate. (see OAR 690-385-5000 and ORS 540.572 to 540.578). A copy of this letter is being sent to any security interest holders listed against your property (as required by statute). A copy of the District Confiscation Policy and Procedures is enclosed for your review.

If you have any evidence that you have used all or part of your water right at any time since 2018, please present the evidence to our office within 30 days from the date of this letter.

I have enclosed an aerial photo showing where your mapped water rights are located. If your water rights are unmapped, the aerial photo will indicate the number of acres of water right and the number of acres of land to assist you in determining how much area should be irrigated. Please note that the aerial photo may not fully represent your irrigation habits for the full irrigation season or any new structures, arenas, dry lots, etc. that may have been added to your property since the aerial photo was taken.

REMINDER: Whether you choose to use, lease, transfer, or not use your water rights in 2023; your 2023 assessments will still be due and payable to OID by the due date.

Dear Patron,

In 2022 you received a certified letter from Owyhee Irrigation District (OID) stating that you have not irrigated a portion or all of your water right since 2018. That letter provided you with the option to request a water transfer, instream lease, or pay your account in full & irrigate the land with the water rights on your property.

The deadline to request an instream lease was February 15th, 2023. We did not receive a request from you, so this is no longer an option.

If you want to permanently transfer the water off the dry area & move it to another area of your property so you can beneficially use your water rights during the 2023 water season, then please call me at #541-372-3540 or email me at krista@owyheeirrigation.org by July 1st 2023.

Please note that you must pay the account balance in full before we can deliver water to any part of your property.

Any portion of your water that has not been beneficially used since 2018 is subject to confiscation in October. If you do not request, or are not approved for a water transfer, your ONLY option to keep the unused water on your property is to use the full water right on the ground exactly as it is mapped in the 2023 water season. Please refer to the water rights map sent to you in October 2022.

This letter serves as notice that OID staff will make one visit to your property between July 1sy — September 1st to physically review the area. If that visit determines any portion of the area subject to confiscation is not being beneficially irrigated, OID will send a certified letter after October 1st informing you of the pending confiscation.

Owyhee Irrigation District or OID reviews water deliveries and maps to track beneficial use of the water rights we deliver. This practice helps OID protect and preserve the water rights that are delivered under our contract with United States Bureau of Reclamation. (1951 Amendatory Contract)

During the 2022 water year review process our records indicate that a <u>portion</u> or <u>all</u> of the water right available to the above-noted property has NOT been beneficially used for 4 consecutive years. Oregon Revised Statute 540.610 clearly states the requirements of beneficial use.

This letter is a request for you to confirm that the information contained herein is correct or provide evidence of any deficiencies.

540.610 Use as measure of water right; presumption of forfeiture of right for nonuse; basis for rebutting presumption; confirmation of rights of municipalities. (1) Beneficial use shall be the basis, the measure, and the limit of all rights to the use of water in this state. Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right ceases or fails to use all or part of the water appropriated for a period of five successive years, the failure to use shall establish a rebuttable presumption of forfeiture of all or part of the water right.

Failure to prove beneficial use as stated is a very serious matter and is cause for forfeiture of the unused water right. At this time, you have <u>3 options</u> to protect this water right, they are as follows:

- 1. You must use the full water right on the ground exactly as it is mapped during the 2023 irrigation season (see enclosed aerial photo for location of mapped water rights)





Owyhee Irrigation District or OID reviews water deliveries and maps to track beneficial use of the water rights we deliver. This practice helps OID protect and preserve the water rights that are delivered under our contract with United States Bureau of Reclamation. (1951 Amendatory Contract)

During the 2022 water year review process our records indicate that a <u>portion</u> or <u>all</u> of the water right available to the above-noted property has NOT been beneficially used for 4 consecutive years. Oregon Revised Statute 540.610 clearly states the requirements of beneficial use.

This letter is a request for you to confirm that the information contained herein is correct or provide evidence of any deficiencies.

540.610 Use as measure of water right; presumption of forfeiture of right for nonuse; basis for rebutting presumption; confirmation of rights of municipalities. (1) Beneficial use shall be the basis, the measure, and the limit of all rights to the use of water in this state. Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right ceases or fails to use all or part of the water appropriated for a period of five successive years, the failure to use shall establish a rebuttable presumption of forfeiture of all or part of the water right.

Failure to prove beneficial use as stated is a very serious matter and is cause for forfeiture of the unused water right. At this time, you have <u>3 options</u> to protect this water right, they are as follows:

In 2022 you received a certified letter from Owyhee Irrigation District (OID) stating that you have not irrigated a portion or all of your water right since 2018. That letter provided you with the option to request a water transfer, instream lease, or pay your account in full & irrigate the land with the water rights on your property.

The deadline to request an instream lease was February 15th, 2023. We did not receive a request from you, so this is no longer an option.

Owyhee Irrigation District or OID reviews water deliveries and maps to track beneficial use of the water rights we deliver. This practice helps OID protect and preserve the water rights that are delivered under our contract with United States Bureau of Reclamation. (1951 Amendatory Contract)

During the 2022 water year review process our records indicate that a <u>portion</u> or <u>all</u> of the water right available to the above-noted property has NOT been beneficially used for 4 consecutive years. Oregon Revised Statute 540.610 clearly states the requirements of beneficial use.

This letter is a request for you to confirm that the information contained herein is correct or provide evidence of any deficiencies.

By this letter, the District is serving you notice of our intent to confiscate the water right referenced above for failure to beneficially use the water for the last 5 consecutive years (See OAR 690-385-5000 and ORS 540.572 to 540.578).
