1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:

a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).

b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

2. Add cfs for the portions of water rights on all the land included in the transfer; however do not count cfs for supplemental rights on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary right on the same land. The fee should be assessed only once for each "on the ground" acre included in the transfer. (In this example, blank 5a would be only 0.56 cfs, since both rights serve the same 45.0 acres. 



 - d. The application involves irrigation water uses only.

DALE DENSON ROUTE 1, BOX 238 HALFWAY, OREGON 97834

confirms the right to use the waters of SPRING CREEK AND DRAINAGE DITCH, a tributary of PINE CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 41.8 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 20.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 41612. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 8, 1977. This right is limited to 1.5 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, 0.75 CFS FROM EACH SOURCE, BEING 1.01 CFS PRIMARY AND 0.49 CFS SUPPLEMENTAL or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 10, T 8 S, R 46 E, W.M.; 680 FEET SOUTH AND 2640 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
