- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:
  - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs  $\div$ 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
  - b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

This transfer application seeks to change the place of use of irrigation Certificate 43725. The Applicant wishes to develop water use over an area of olive trees and grape vines which exists partially within and partially outside of the existing place of use. These "to" lands currently receive irrigation from water deliveries. Irrigation under the existing right and from the existing diversion would be much for efficient and financially viable than continuing to pay for trucked water. The proposed transfer does not include changes to the character of use or the point of diversion on Graver Creek.

The Applicant utilizes a portable pumping system at the point of diversion to pump water from Graver Creek to the place of use. The proposed place of use ("to" lands) currently has high-efficiency drip lines set up for irrigation from trucked deliveries. The Applicant proposes to connect the place of use to the point of diversion with portable surface distribution lines, which may be moved to connect to different portions of the place of use.





Please find accompanying this letter a copy of an Application for a Permanent Water Right Transfer on behalf of Paola Roselli **or** Kim Hartman (Applicants). The Applicants are proposing to change the place of use (POU) of Certificate 43725 for irrigation from a point of diversion (POD) on Graver Creek. The current POU of Certificate 43725 includes acres located off of the Applicant's property, though this transfer only affects acres within the Applicant's property totaling to approximately 11.6 acres.

The Applicants wish to move irrigation acres to cover areas where they hope to develop olive trees, grape vines, and other crops. The "from" areas will be used primarily as pasture lands. The Applicant understands that the transfer review process may take several years. Based on communications with the local Watermaster, the Applicant is therefore also applying for a limited license to use water over the "to" lands of this transfer until the transfer is completed. The limited license application, which will expire when this transfer is approved, is also included in this submittal.
