- Notice of the application for ground water registration modification was published on May 15, 2012, pursuant to OAR 690-382-0600. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 8. On November 6, 2012, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Groundwater Registration Modification Application T-11417 to the applicants. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of December 7, 2012, for the applicants to respond. The applicants requested that the

Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicants are authorized to pursue the Groundwater Registration Modification.

9. On November 30, 2012, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Groundwater Registration Modification Application T-11417 and sent a copy to the applicants. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the Groundwater Registration Modification application was published on the Department's weekly notice on November 30, 2012, and in the Grants Pass Daily Courier newspaper on December 6 and 13, 2012, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

Review Criteria for Ground Water Registration Modification Applications [OAR 690-382-0700(2)]

- 10. The proposed modifications would not result in enlargement of the ground water registration. The proposed modifications would not result in a state Scenic Waterway not receiving previously available water during periods in which streamflows are less than the quantities determined by the Department to be necessary to meet the requirements of ORS 390.835.
- 11. The proposed modifications would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The modification in point of appropriation and modification in place of use proposed in Ground Water Registration Modification T-11417 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.610, 537.705, 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-382-1000.

- 2. The use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Registration Application GR-4090 (Certificate of Registration GR-3860) and any related decree.
- 3. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
- 4. Water shall no longer be appropriated from the original point of appropriation as part of this ground water certificate of registration.

- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
- 6. The former place of use of the modified ground water registration shall no longer receive water as part of the ground water certificate of registration.
- 7. Water use measurement conditions:

a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at the new point of appropriation.

b. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.

c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

- 6. Notice of the application for ground water registration modification was published on May 15, 2012, pursuant to OAR 690-382-0600. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 7. On November 6, 2012, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Groundwater Registration Modification Application T-11417 to the applicants. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of December 7, 2012, for the applicants to respond. The applicants requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the

necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the Groundwater Registration Modification.

Review Criteria for Ground Water Registration Modification Applications [OAR 690-382-0700(2)]

- 8. The proposed modifications would not result in enlargement of the ground water registration. The proposed modifications would not result in a state Scenic Waterway not receiving previously available water during periods in which streamflows are less than the quantities determined by the Department to be necessary to meet the requirements of ORS 390.835.
- 9. The proposed modifications would not result in injury to other water rights.

Determination and Proposed Action

The modification in point of appropriation and modification in place of use proposed in Ground Water Registration Modification T-11417 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.610, 537.705, 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-382-1000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the modification will be approved.

If Ground Water Registration Modification T-11417 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- The modifications to Registration Application GR-4090 (Certificate of Registration GR-3860) proposed in Ground Water Registration Modification Application T-11417 are recognized. Recognition of the modifications shall not be construed as a final determination of the right to appropriate ground water under the certificate of registration or modification. Such a determination will occur in an adjudication proceeding under ORS 537.670 to 537.695.
- 2. The use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Registration Application GR-4090 (Certificate of Registration GR-3860) and any related decree.
- 3. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
- 4. Water shall no longer be appropriated from the original point of appropriation as part of this ground water certificate of registration.
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.





We are proposing to transfer the point of appropriation and place of use for 12 acres. There are 15 acres in the SE/SW of section 9, T38S, R7W, W.M. We have been irrigating approximately 15 acres on tax lot 702 as the neighbor to the east (TL-794) has never irrigated as long as we have lived on our property. Be that as it may, we are claiming 12 of the 15 acres as that is what we believe was appurtenant to our property (TL-702) in the original registration.

We dug the sump we are currently using in 1982 or 1983 and have used it to irrigate continuously since that time.

Before we dug the sump we were advised by the watermaster's office to cancel our claim to GR-3860, and file for a new permit. This was confusing to us since we believe our sump is the same ground water source as the sump identified in the claim. We decided to dig the sump and use it under GR-3860 and wait for the adjudication of ground water claims.

We would now like to solidify our intentions and to take advantage of the recent legislation that allows for modification of ground water registrations.







The authorized POA is a sump (14 feet deep per application GR 4090) located approximately 2600 feet east (upstream) from the proposed POA. <u>The proposed POA is an existing, 14 or 18 feet deep sump (the application states different depths in different places for the proposed POA).</u>
- 2. Will the proposed POA develop the same aquifer (source) as the existing authorized POA?
 X Yes No Comments: <u>GR 4090 describes the sump as 14 feet deep, with sandy loam to 10 feet below land surface (BLS), gravel and fines from 10 to 14 feet BLS. Well logs in the area describe similar materials at shallow depths, so it is reasonable to assume the proposed POA accesses the same aquifer.</u>
- a) Is there more than one source developed under the right (e.g., basalt and alluvium)?
 Yes No Both sumps are in the Quaternary alluvium of Deer Creek. There is no information indicating there are distinct aquifers within the alluvium.

Yes No Comments: The nearest groundwater right to the proposed POA is 1780 feet <u>NW of the sump</u>, while Deer Creek is 150 feet from the proposed POA. The cone of depression caused by pumping at the sump will intercept the Creek before it affects other groundwater users. <u>Therefore</u>, the new POA is expected to affect other groundwater users similarly to the authorized <u>POA</u>.

Yes No Comments: <u>Hunt (1999) model indicates the proposed POA will cause an</u> increase in interference with Deer Creek. There are no site-specific aquifer parameters available. This model is most sensitive to variations in streambed hydraulic conductivity, so a range of values was tested. The lowest (1 ft/d) is probably overly conservative, more likely to describe a silty-sand streambed than the cobble streambed observed near the site. The streambed materials are coarse, consisting of cobbles with some sand and gravel; streambed hydraulic conductivity is expected to be on the order of 10 ft/day or greater. Using this streambed hydraulic conductivity, the Jenkins and Hunt (1999) models converge in less than 30 days. Both models show an increase in interference with surface water at the proposed POA.

Pumping at either the authorized or the proposed location will create a cone of depression that intersects the stream in less than one day. Given the uncertainty in estimating site-specific aquifer parameters and streambed conductivity, a 0.013 cfs increase in interference is considered minimal for the purposes of this review.

Please accept our application for modification of ground water registration certificate GR-3860.

We are proposing to transfer the point of appropriation and place of use for 12 acres. There are 15 acres in the SE/SW of section 9, T38S, R7W, W.M. We have been irrigating approximately 15 acres on tax lot 702 as the neighbor to the east (TL-794) has never irrigated as long as we have lived on our property. Be that as it may, we are claiming 12 of the 15 acres as that is what we believe was appurtenant to our property (TL-702) in the original registration.

We dug the sump we are currently using in 1982 or 1983 and have used it to irrigate continuously since that time.

Before we dug the sump we were advised by the watermaster's office to cancel our claim to GR-3860, and file for a new permit. This was confusing to us since we believe our sump is the same ground water source as the sump identified in the claim. We decided to dig the sump and use it under GR-3860 and wait for the adjudication of ground water claims.

We would now like to solidify our intentions and to take advantage of the recent legislation that allows for modification of ground water registrations.


