The landowner wishes to adjust the irrigation areas to match changes in the place of use due to crop changes. The owner is requesting consideration of new well locations on the new place of use to alleviate the need for an easement to use the original well. Two well locations are proposed just in case one location is not approved and to have a second location to try if the first new well does not produce adequately. If a new well location is not approved or a new well does not produce adequately, an easement to the original well will be created.

If a new well location is approved, the landowner plans to try a well at POA #2 first. If that well does not produce, then POA #3 will be attempted.


